2. Description of the Action Being Approved

This is a sole source action submitted for approval to award a Firm Fixed Priced contract for the procurement of three active shooter Judgment Based Engagement Training and Tactics (JETT) case study videos as required by Center for Security Forces (CENSECFOR) located in Virginia Beach, VA. This requirement will be awarded subject to FAR Subpart 13.5 – "Test Program for Certain Commercial Items."

3. Description of Supplies/Services

CENSECFOR requires the procurement of follow on active shooter JETT case study videos in response to the recent active shooter incidents aboard the USS Mahan, Washington Navy Yard, Navy Recruiting Station Chattanooga, and Naval Operations Support Center, Chattanooga, TN. Parroco Productions Group has produced a training video for CENSECFOR on the topic of active shooter response. The existing active shooter JETT video does not cover the aforementioned incidents, and as a result, new JETT case study videos are required. In order to properly integrate continuously as follow on case studies with the existing JETT video, film material, vignettes, and backgrounds currently owned by Parroco Productions Group must be utilized in the new case studies. The placement of a Firm Fixed Priced contract is anticipated. The required delivery date is February 2017 with interim targets for each of the three videos. Fiscal Year 2016 Operations and Maintenance, Navy (O&M,N) funds have been provided.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition

The statutory authority for this action is Section 4202 of the Clinger-Cohen Act of 1996, a sole source acquisition under the authority of the test program for certain commercial items, as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation FAR 13.501(a).

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority

The proposed sole source requirement is to acquire JETT case study videos as a follow on to an existing JETT video produced by Parroco Productions Group. As Parroco Productions Group is the copyright holder of existing vignettes and other video footage used in the existing JETT video, only Parroco Productions Group may produce and film follow on JETT videos using existing Parroco Productions Group vignettes and training backgrounds. As these three JETT videos

are designed to serve as a supplement to the existing JETT video, no other vendor can provide the required JETT videos in form, fit, and function with the existing JETT video without significant costs to produce and develop the entire series of videos.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable

This requirement will be synopsisized and the solicitation will be posted on the Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) website with the stated intent of awarding on a sole source basis with Parroco Productions Group.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost

The Procuring Contracting Officer will make a determination of fair and reasonableness of price based upon price analysis in accordance with FAR 13.106-3.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 5, FLCN has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the required follow on active shooter JETT videos. Other training video requirements will be competitively sourced and awarded.
