**NOTICE 03 – REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

**QUESTION(Q) 30:** In Part 3, paragraph 2.2 Environmental Requirements it states: “Contractor shall comply with the requirements of the US Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) and US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) in addition to the requirements of the basic contract. A US ACOE permit is required for this project. Government will obtain permit”. Please provide copy of ACOE permit or draft permit and any EPA requirements for this project. Alternatively, provide list of “permit conditions and requirements” that Contractor will need to comply with for this dredging project. Without this information, it is impossible to properly assess the effort and cost to complete the dredging work.

**RESPONSE(R) 30:** ACOE permit is not available at this time. Anticipated permit requirements are provided in the RFP documents.

**Q31:** In Part 3, paragraph 2.1.1, a. 7. Explosive Safety Submission (ESS), a Munitions and Explosives of Concern (MEC) Clearance Work Plan is required. Is the Contractor required to include the submerged areas to be dredged (underwater MEC) in the ESS? Or will the ESS only address the areas to be cleared on land?

**R31:** ESS shall apply to areas cleared on land and all work required in the CDF. Submerged areas (underwater MEC) is not required.

**Q32:** To plan for typhoon conditions to protect floating equipment and personnel, will the Contractor be allowed to establish a storm mooring within the inner Apra Harbor? Without the capability to safely moor and secure the floating equipment, the equipment could be damaged by typhoon storm conditions.

**R32:** The Contractor will be permitted to establish storm mooring within the inner Apra Harbor. The Contractor shall submit a storm mooring plan for Government review prior to implementation.

**Q33:** In RFI Notice 02, the response to Q23 stated: “The Contractor shall include allowance for two feet over-dredge tolerances in the proposal.” Please confirm that all material dredged to the two feet over-dredge tolerance depth will be included in the measured volume of dredge material for payment purposes.

**R33:** Confirmed. All material dredged to the two feet over-dredge tolerance depth will be included in the measured volume of dredge material for payment purposes.
