



Deliverable 4.1.1

The Contractor will be required to produce draft technical reports containing SCI information generated from attendance at a series of TS/SCI level technical meetings on the subject of Multi-INT. The assigned Technical POC and CORE for the contract and the Director of the NPS Center for Multi-INT Studies will both be responsible for overseeing and monitoring production of the reports as well as reviewing the contents and ensuring all material is properly maintained and

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marked. Distribution of these reports will only take place via the Government Wide Area Network (GWAN), Contractor Wide Area Network (CWAN), or Joint Worldwide Intelligence Communication System (JWICS).

Deliverable 4.1.10

This task requires the Contractor to attend a IC agency sponsored 3-day technical meeting in Chantilly, VA. The meeting is at the TS/SCI level. Attendance at the meeting is required for compiling the information needed to produce one of the reports associated with Deliverable 4.1.1 noted above.

Each week CMIS staff participates in a weekly project coordination meeting with the sponsor. The meeting is at the TS/SCI level.
