

SOLE SOURCE JUSTIFICATION FOR SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITIONS

1. The service listed on purchase request **M20364-12-SU-00058** is available from only one source and competition is precluded for reasons indicated below. There are no substitutes available.

3. Description of the service required, the estimated cost, and required delivery date.

This requirement is for specialized training in support of CBIRF's missions when responding to a Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, and/or High Yield Explosive (CBRNE) event.

The period of performance is 26 March to 30 March 2012. The total estimated cost is \$48,743.47.

4. Specific characteristics of the service that limit the availability to a sole source e.g., unique features, function of the item, etc. Describe in detail why only this suggested source can furnish the requirements to the exclusion of other sources.

The Department of Homeland Security National Response Framework Guidelines establishes general concepts on response to CBRNE attacks; CONPLAN 3500 outlines CBIRF's requirement to response, 29 CFR 1910.120 provides technical rescue guidelines, and NAVMC 3500.29 (CBIRF's Training and Readiness Manual) provides training requirements.

Camp Gruber is the only known location in the United States that can offer a large amount of quality simulated collapsed structures in one centralized area that can meet the extensive training requirements outlined in the guidelines above. The facilities and venues found aboard Camp Gruber have been developed continuously over the last seven years and are determined to be safe environments to conduct the types of high risk training associated with CBIRF's overall mission. Based on the Memorandum of Understanding between the Army's Joint Force Headquarters – Oklahoma and Response International Group (RIG), RIG has been identified as the only authorized vendor capable of providing training by directly managing and utilizing the training facilities aboard the camp. Due to this memorandum, RIG is the only vendor capable of fulfilling the agency's requirements to train aboard Camp Gruber at this time.
