HRSAP Analysis Contract M67004-10-F-0346 Extension

**"JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL FOR
USE OF OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION"**

1. Contracting Activity. Marine Corps Logistics Command, 814 Radford Blvd. Door 240 Cubicle NE10, Albany, GA 31704

2. Description of Action Being Approved.

Sole Source six month extension to current contract (M67004-10-F-0346) to execute additional surveys (new work).

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

This J&A authorizes and approves the award of a sole-source, firm-fixed price contract modification to Systems Research and Applications Corporation (SRA), FED ID#54-1013306, P.O. Box 34880, Alexandria, Virginia 22334 for analysis support services in support of DMDC, HRSAP.

The period of performance is January 26, 2012 to July 26, 2012. The maximum value of this procurement is \$.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition.

Source Selection Information – See FAR 2.101 and 3.104

Statutory Authority permitting other than full and open competition is 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1), as implemented by FAR 6.302-1©(ii)(B) is appropriate as only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements and unacceptable delays in fulfilling the agency's requirements would have a severe impact on agency's mission.

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority.

SRA is currently under contract performing the described services. The survey analysis work requires new work for an additional 6 months. The basis of the sole source justification is due to being a follow-on acquisition for a short duration of 6 months as implemented in FAR 6.302-1(a)(2)(iii). The original contract was advertised and awarded under full and open competition.

The original contract for HRSAP Analysis support was competed and awarded to SRA on July 26, 2010. SRA developed, produced, and delivered the analysis support at a significant cost to the Government and over a significant period of time. As a result, an award to any other source would result in a substantial duplication of cost and time delay to the Government. Costs that would be unnecessarily duplicated would involve set-up and transition activities. Based on past actual costs, the estimated corresponding amount would be between \$500,000 and \$700,000. In addition, award to a source other than the SRA would result in an unacceptable delay of approximately 3 months in fulfilling the Government's requirements. This delay impacts the Government's ability to meet its mission because the work survey sponsors require timely analysis of the surveys recently fielded.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Possible

The original contract was advertised and awarded under full and open competition. The basis of the sole source justification is due to being a follow-on acquisition for a short duration of 6 months as implemented in FAR 6.302-1(a)(2)(iii).

Market research for the initial requirement was conducted by synopsis of the proposed action, advising industry, and soliciting information from interested parties in accordance with FAR Part 10. The initial requirement was synopsized in FedBizOps in accordance with the requirements for FAR 5.2. Only one response was received.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.

The Contracting Officer will determine if the anticipated cost to the Government for the services covered by this J&A is fair and reasonable. The fair and reasonableness of the cost will be based on an analysis of the contractor's cost proposal, including backup information supporting the cost. In addition, a comparison against similar survey analysis contract costs will be evaluated. This analysis will be conducted using experienced technical representatives.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.

The Marine Corps has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/services covered by this J&A. No future competition through this contracting activity is planned. This is a one-time six month extension as provided for in the existing contract.
