MEMORANDUM FOR RECORD BRAND NAME / SOLE SOURCE JUSTIFICATION FOR SIMPLIFIED ACQUISITION (\$3000 < PR < \$150,000) M67400-FY12-SSBN27

1. The service listed on purchase request MMF100-12-SU-20155-0001 and further described below, is available from only one source and competition is precluded for reasons indicated below. There are no substitutes available.

3. **Description of the services required, the estimated cost, and the required performance period:**

The requirement is for the procurement of cleaning and pump out services for Government-owned portable, fiberglass polyethylene, non-flush type, chemical toilets throughout Marine Corps Camp Ie Shima in support of Base Property Control Office (BPCO), MCB Camp S.D. Butler, Okinawa. The contractor is responsible for the cleaning and pump out of each portable toilet to include, rinsing of tanks, wiping down the entire interior, wiping down each toilet seat with a clean towel that has been dipped in approved disinfectant solution, and drying each seat with a clean dry towel. The contractor shall pump and dispose of waste at facilities approved by the local government authorities or authorized and approved U.S. Military facilities. Contractor shall comply with all regulations and laws in regards to the disposal security and environmental controls with U.S Military Service, Government of Japan, Local Municipality, and Okinawa Prefecture Government requirements.

Approval is requested to extend the contract for the Portable Toilet Cleaning Services under Purchase Order Number M67400-07-P-0185 which expires on 30 April 2012 for an additional one month. A one month extension was previously awarded on Modification P00009 extending the period of performance from 01 April 2012 to 30 April 2012 in the estimated amount of ¥67,200 (\$736.42 = FY12@¥91,2524). This sole source action will extend the period of performance from 01 May 2012 to 31 May 2012 hereby total two month extension period allowed for under the Option to Extend Services clause, FAR 52.217-8. The estimated cost of this extension is ¥75,600 (\$828.47) for a total two month extension cost of ¥142,800 (\$1,564.89).

4. **Specific characteristics of the requirement that limits the availability to a particular provider. Describe in detail why only this suggested source can furnish the requirements to the exclusion of other sources:**

Although FAR Clause 52.217-8 was included in the contract, the value of the option was not included in the price evaluation conducted prior to contract award. In a GAO ruling dated 14 September 2009, if the value of the option was not included in the price evaluation, a J&A is required before the option can be exercised.

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Exercising the option clause stated above will provide continued contractual coverage for the pump out and cleaning of Government-owned portable toilet services in support of the BPCO, Okinawa, Japan. The Government requires the continuation of the Services in order to meet urgent deployment and contingencies. The required services are deemed to be available only from Niijima Denki Suido Kojisha because it is likely that award to any other source would result in unacceptable delays in fulfilling the BPCO mission requirements. The purpose of this extension is to maintain continuity by obtaining the services from the incumbent provider for the minimum period of time necessary to solicit and award a new contract. If the Government were to compete a one month contract, it is highly unlikely that there would be competition for this requirement since the period of performance is only for one month. The follow-on requirement has been solicited on NECO using full and open competition procedures, has been evaluated, and the award paperwork is currently being completed and reviewed however, the follow-on will not be awarded before 01 May.


