

Marine Corps Systems Command Industry Day Announcement

This announcement provides notice that the United States Marine Corps (USMC), Marine Corps Systems Command (MCSC), Marine Air-Ground Task Force (MAGTF) Command, Control, and Communications (MC3), Radar Systems Program Manager intends to hold an unclassified Pre-solicitation Conference (Industry Day) beginning at 9:00 A.M. on 27 March 2012 at Marine Corps Base (MCB) Camp Pendleton, CA. Industry Day will be held at Marine Corps Tactical Systems Software Activity (MCTSSA).

The purpose of the event is to provide an overview of the planned procurement of fifteen (15) maintenance lift assemblies for the AN/TPS-59A(V)3 Radars. The AN/TPS-59A(V)3 Project Officer will present a brief on the planned production, current challenges, and delivery strategy for the maintenance lift assemblies. The exchange of information is to improve potential offerors' understanding of the Government's requirements and increase efficiency in future proposal preparations and thereby enhance the Government's ability to obtain quality supplies and services at reasonable and affordable prices.

Attendance is limited to a maximum of 3 individuals per organization. Attendance at the Industry Day is voluntary and is not required to propose to subsequent solicitations (if any) on this topic.

As a prerequisite to accessing MCTSSA, you must first have access to Camp Pendleton. Please contact the Base Access Control Branch at (760) 763-1220 for base access requirements. At a minimum you will be required to present a valid driver's license, proof of insurance, and a valid vehicle registration.

Upon arrival at MCTSSA the gate guards will direct you to the Visitor Parking Lot and Visitor Center. Once you are in the Visitor Center, be prepared to present a picture ID, state the nature and duration of your visit and provide the name of your MCTSSA point of contact (POC).
