



## Solicitation N00024-11-R-4402 Bidder's Questions – 13 June 2011

### **Bidder's Question 11**

On page 139 of the draft solicitation, under the Management Approach section of the instructions for preparing the Technical Proposal, Offerors are instructed to discuss the Offeror's facility security plan related to ship and crew protection when work is being performed within the Offeror's facility. Since the work will be performed at Naval Station Everett or another Government facility, should this requirement be removed from the Technical Proposal? Additionally, the draft solicitation contains numerous references/requirements relating to contracts where the ships are worked on in the contractor's facility. Will those references/requirements be removed from the final solicitation?

### **Answer**

Work on the ships covered under the proposed contract will be performed at Naval Station Everett or another Government facility. While the final solicitation will not require Offerors to describe the facility security plan for work to be accomplished within an Offeror's facility, the Section L provision entitled "FACILITY SECURITY CLEARANCE" does apply to the solicitation and a Contract Security Classification Specification, DD Form 254, will be incorporated at the time of contract award.
