Bidder's Question 3

Are attachments to the draft solicitation and any information identified in the draft solicitation as available upon request also considered draft documents?

Answer

Yes. All attachments and documents that form a part of the draft solicitation package, including any documents that are provided to potential Offerors upon request, must be considered draft documents and are subject to change prior to release of the final solicitation. However, as stated in the pre-solicitation notice, the draft status of the solicitation package should not preclude potential Offerors from using the draft documents to begin proposal preparations, as major revisions are not expected and changes will be clearly identified at the time the final solicitation package is released.
