**LOCATION**

NBVC, Port Hueneme is located on the Oxnard Plains 60 miles NW of Los Angeles, along the California coastline in Ventura County between Los Angeles and Santa Barbara.



## **CLIMATE**

Moderate year round. Light jacket appropriate for late afternoon/evening.

The Ventura County coastal area is comforted by a gentle marine influence that creates a year-round, pleasant, "Mediterranean-type" climate with mild and comfortable temperatures. During the summer months, the ambient temperatures are generally about ten degrees cooler than the Los Angeles area, while in winter months, the temperatures are warmer than inland California areas.

## **DRIVING DIRECTIONS**

**There are two primary routes from Los Angeles Airport (LAX) to NBVC, Port Hueneme:**

The **Pacific Coast Highway (CA 1)** is a two-lane highway - this is the most scenic route which is usually the fastest, except on weekdays from 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM.

From LAX airport go east to on-ramp Interstate 405 north, then take Interstate 10 west which turns into Hwy 1 north along the coast, go past Malibu, go past Point Mugu, exit Pleasant Valley Road west, turn left on to Pleasant Valley Road, turn right on Ventura Road and turn left at Sunkist Gate.

The **Ventura Freeway (US 101)** route is 3-5 lanes and is subject to heavy traffic during rush hours.

From LAX airport, go east to on-ramp Interstate 405 north, be alert for the intersection and exit Hwy 101 north, go past Camarillo, and exit Victoria Road. Turn left on Victoria Road, turn left on Channel Islands Blvd., turn right on Ventura Rd, and turn right on Sunkist Street. Turn right before the NBVC Port Hueneme gate to enter SECURITY/BADGE and PASS office.

At the Sunkist Gate, park at the Badge and Pass Office which will be located on your right side; personnel and vehicle passes will be ready in advance of your arrival, inform the security specialist of the meeting you will be attending.

**All attendees are to meet at the Sunkist gate at 0800 for escort to Building 506. Escort will depart promptly at 0815. In the event an attendee misses the escort, directions to Building 506 are below.**

### **Directions to Building 506 from the Sunkist Gate Badge and Pass Office:**

Enter Sunkist Gate and proceed directly ahead on 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue to Pacific Road. Turn Left onto Pacific Road. Proceed on Pacific Road and cross Pleasant Valley Road. Building 506 is on the right hand side just after the intersection. Proceed through gate and park next to the building in designated parking areas. (Please see Page 6 for map.)

## **NBVC GATE HOURS**

**Personnel entering Navy facilities must present a CAC card. If you don't have a CAC card, you will be required to notify the NSWC PHD POC and stop at the Badge and Pass Office (located at the Sunkist Gate) to present your I-9 form. For additional instructions:**

### **Attendee Registration, Base Access and Visit Requests**

#### **All Attendees:**

All Attendees must meet at the Sunkist Gate at 0800 on 4 June 2012 for escort to Building 506. Escort departs promptly at 0815. Please follow the below instructions for obtaining base access.

#### **Foreign National / Non US Citizen Visit Request POC:**

Please notify the NSWC PHD POC's of your intent to attend the industry day and identify your place of lodging while visiting NBVC Port Hueneme. Submit your Visit Request through standard channels.

Please ensure you bring your passport or foreign military identification, this will be required at the Badge and Pass Office to obtain your Foreign National Visitors Badge and gain access into the Command.

#### **Personnel with CAC Card:**

Please notify industry day POC of your intent to attend industry day. Proceed through gate with CAC and Rental Car Agreement.

#### **Personnel with no CAC Card:**

Please notify industry day and NSWC PHD POC of your intent to attend the industry day and submit your I-9 Form to the NSWC PHD POC, no later than 23 May 2012. Your sponsor will be the PHD NSWC POC.

To request installation access, interested parties must complete the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) I-9 Form. The completed and signed DHS I-9 Form must be submitted to the NSWC PHD POC by 23 May 2012 and presented at the Pass and Identification Office or the CAC Office, depending on the type of badge, at the time of badge issuance. No badge will be issued to a contractor or a sub-contractor without a completed and signed DHS I-9 Form.


