A technical review was completed by reviewing the results of previous market research for identical items to determine and identify all known sources as of 6 Feb 2015. The results of this review have determined that no new sources have been qualified to manufacture this item. Atlas American Corp. dba. Pro Battery Specialists, has expressed an interest in becoming qualified; however, to date they have not pursued qualification any further.
