4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY:

10 USC 2304(c)(1), as implemented by Federal Acquisition Regulation 6.302-1.

5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:

The current Acquisition Method Suffix Code is: 3C

This acquisition will be negotiated with: Martin Baker Aircraft Co. LTD, Cage Code: U1604

These parts are Air Critical Safety Items and must be procured from an approved source designated by the design control activity in order to maintain the quality of the part. Existing unique design capability, engineering skills, and manufacturing knowledge by the qualified source require acquisition of the part from the approved source.

6. GOVERNMENT WIDE POINT OF ENTRY NOTICE / POTENTIAL SOURCES:

The proposed solicitation will be synopsised in the FEDBIZOPPS, which is the Government wide Point of Entry (GPE).

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. In instances when certified cost and pricing data are required, an analysis of cost information will be performed which will consider field pricing reports, commerciality, procurement history and other available cost and pricing information in determining price reasonableness. Certified cost and pricing data will be obtained and used to ensure reasonableness, completeness and realism of proposed costs as required.

8. DESCRIPTION OF MARKET SURVEY: A technical review was completed to determine and identify all

known sources. The results of this review, completed on May 23, 2014, have determined that no new sources have expressed an interest in manufacturing this item.

9. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS: The articles to be procured are complex and must meet operational and reliability

requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing. (3C) These parts are Air Critical Safety Items and must be procured from an approved source designated by the design control activity in order to maintain the quality of the part. The approved source retains the data rights, manufacturing knowledge or technical data that are not economically available to the Government and the data or knowledge is essential to maintaining the quality of the part. Therefore, acquisition is restricted to Martin Baker Aircraft Co.


