This MT-30 Ancillary Parts Kit is specific to the Littoral Combat Ship Freedom Variant Hull #1 and #3. Congress has directed the Department of the Navy to Support this configuration as a result of a competitive ship contract. The design of the Freedom Class is locked and the funds have been directly allocated by the U.S. Congress for the sole purpose of Battle Spare procurement of this equipment.

6. DESCRIPTION OF EFFORTS MADE TO SOLICIT OFFERS FROM AS MANY OFFERORS AS PRACTICABLE: The proposed contract action was synopsisized and included a Sources Sought Notice on the FedBizOpps website for government-wide point of entry on
