5. DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:

7. DETERMINATION OF FAIR AND REASONABLE COST: The contracting officer determines that the anticipated cost to the Government will be fair and reasonable. ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS: The articles to be procured are complex and must meet operational and reliability requirements, the achievement of which requires unique production techniques and extensive and/or sophisticated testing. (3B) The government has not yet acquired or developed the technical data. Therefore, acquisition is restricted to: Martin-Baker LTD.
