1. Contracting Activity

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority

The Joint Rapid Action Cell (JRAC) placed a requirement on the Navy and in particular NAVEODTECHDIV's Technical Support

Detachment (TSD) in 2 May 2010 to fulfill [REDACTED]

The timeline for this requirement is highly compressed, with a full roll out of material and non-material assets due in theater by 31 July 2010. In order to meet this urgent need, it is necessary that a contract vehicle be awarded that can provide the essential labor assets required to fill this vital

[REDACTED] Engility, an affiliate of L-3 Communication, currently provides NAVEODTECHDIV/TSD with the highly skilled technicians and engineers uniquely suited for the [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] under contract N00178-04-D-4143 FG01. Engility is uniquely situated in the fact that they have been involved with the [REDACTED] since 2004 and have been providing the specialized personnel required by the JUONS. Engility has the labor pool and the ability to fill these positions within the timeframe required by this [REDACTED]. The Government does not have the time or money to get another contractor up to speed on this mission. To award to anyone other than Engility would cause potential loss of life to US and allied forces [REDACTED]

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable

The NAVEODTECHDIV is very familiar with the market and the very limited number of contractors that have the ability to quickly provide specialized skilled personnel in theater. Due to the urgent timeframe to have personnel in theater, it is imperative that the contractor with [REDACTED] experience be utilized. Therefore, only Engility is being solicited at this time. The proposed contract is intended for 1 year in an effort to provide a platform for rapid acquisition and [REDACTED]

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Costs

The Contracting Officer will determine that the anticipated cost to the Government for the supplies/services covered by the J&A will be fair and reasonable prior to contract award. This analysis will be conducted using price and cost analysis techniques as provided for in FAR part 15.4.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Competition

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 6, NAVEODTECHDIV/TSD intends to provide competition for the efforts required in the follow-on years.
