JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL FOR OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION

JUSTIFICATION

1. Contracting Activity

The Naval Sea Systems Command, Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Contracts Division.

2. Description of the Action Being Approved

This justification is for the award of a cost-plus-fixed-fee term contract on a sole source basis to procure technical support services of the Industrial Logistics Support Information Management System (ILSMIS). The only company capable of fulfilling this requirement is CACI Dynamic Systems of 1100 North Glebe Road, Arlington, Virginia 22201.

3. Description of Supplies/Services

This requirement is for the operation, maintenance, database management, user assistance, and training support for ILSMIS, for database management of Sponsor Owned Material (SOM) assets on the Regional Residual Asset Management (R-RAMS) system located at Dahlgren, Virginia. The support shall include functional analysis and improvement support to NSWCDD's business process for material and property management, inventory control, financial interface and procurement, which utilizes various systems including ILSMIS, SPS Adapter and R-RAMS.

The Government's minimum needs have been verified by the certifying technical and requirements personnel. The estimated value of this two year contract, including a one-year base period and a one-year option period, is \$498,902 and will utilize Navy Working Capital Funds.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Other Than Full and Open Competition

10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1), as implemented by FAR 6.302-1, only one responsible source and no other supplies or services will satisfy agency requirements.

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority

NSWCDD requires technical support services of ILSMIS and SOM assets on the R-RAMS. CACI is currently providing the support under N00178-06-C-1001 and has the corporate resources with specific knowledge, specialized experience, and expertise to support ILSMIS and maintain the SOM assets on the R-RAMS.

It is essential to procure the required technical support from CACI to provide continuity of services. No other company possesses the unique working knowledge of the ILSMIS system's interfaces with NSWCDD's other internal financial systems. In addition, ILSMIS is a legacy system that will be phased out within the next two years due to the implementation of Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP). Due to the depth and breadth of knowledge that CACI possesses, it is estimated that any other company would have an approximate six-month learning curve that could jeopardize NSWCDD's financial processes. Given the unwavering timeframe for the ERP implementation, and based on the above information, it is not financially viable for the Government to seek competition for technical support on a legacy system that will no longer be utilized after the implementation of ERP.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable.

The proposed contract was synopsisized via posting on the Federal Business Opportunities website on 17 August 2010 in accordance with FAR 5.2. Only CACI expressed an interest in this requirement. No additional market research was conducted because it is not practicable, for the reasons discussed in paragraph 5 above, for any company other than CACI to provide the required services.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Costs

The Contracting Officer has determined that the anticipated cost to the Government for the supplies/services covered by the J&A will be fair and reasonable.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Competition

For the reasons set forth in paragraph 5, NSWCCD has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, NSWCCD will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
