

**SECURING WINDOWS AND RESISTING MALWARE
STATEMENT OF WORK**

1.0 INTRODUCTION

Department of Defense (DoD) Directive 8570.01 requires Information Assurance (IA) workforce personnel to maintain their current certifications following the certification vendor's maintenance process. Global Information Assurance Certification (GIAC) is maintained by earning continual learning points/units. The Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division, (NSWCDD) must prepare IA workforce members for GIAC certifications and to reach DoD Directive 8570.01 compliance.

The NSWCDD requires the delivery of one SANS Securing Windows and Resisting Malware SEC505. As cyber threat activities have increased, the need for IA personnel to have an in-depth knowledge of techniques to secure the Windows operating system against advanced targeted attacks while minimizing the impact of security features and policies to the command's users and mission is critical to mitigating the risks of the cyber-attacks. This course focuses on the security aspect of Windows instead of simply addressing installation, standard configuration, and maintenance of the Windows operating system. This will enhance the command Cyber/IA security posture as more secure architectures/deployments of Windows systems are deployed.

2.0 SPECIFIC TASK REQUIREMENTS

2.1 The contractor shall provide American National Standards Institute (ANSI) International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 17024 accredited training on the topic of Securing Windows and Resisting Malware;

2.2 The contractor shall deliver the course, SANS SEC505: Securing Windows and Resisting Malware, during the awarded period of performance to NSWC Dahlgren in support of the Department of the Navy DoD Information Assurance program;

2.3 The contractor shall provide instruction by a certified faculty member;

2.4 The contractor shall provide the course for a maximum of 15 participants over a period of five days;

2.5 The contractor shall provide one laptop per student for the class instruction;

2.6 The contractor shall provide all course books and materials; and

2.7 The contractor shall provide certificates of completion for all participants satisfactorily meeting the learning requirements of the course.

3.0 TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Instructor's travel shall be included in the basic contract requirements.

4.0 TECHNICAL POINT OF CONTACT

The technical point of contact for this task delivery will be given at the issuance of the award.

5.0 GOVERNMENT FURNISHED INFORMATION

NSWCDD will provide suitable classroom facilities, a complete list of names, phone numbers, and email addresses of personnel attending the course, and a copy of copyright and proprietary rights license signed by each student who is to participate in the class.
