Subj: **JUSTIFICATION FOR URGENT ACQUISITION OF CONTROLLED SYSTEMS TECHNICAL SUPPORT**

URGENCY: This justification is provided to support the processing of reference (a) on an urgent basis (i.e., more quickly than the routine cycle timeframes of 30 days for requirements greater than \$3,000 but less than \$150,000. Processing of a requirement on an urgent basis may allow the soliciting from a single source if Contracting Officer determines that the circumstances deem only one source reasonably available. This justification is based on the following facts:

1. Date on which the requirement was first identified. 04 Sep 2014
2. Date on which the requirement was submitted. 10 Sep 2014
3. Required delivery date. 10 Sep 2014
4. Explanation of the special circumstances and conditions that exist validating the requirement as "urgent".
Ship's Force does not have the capability or training to troubleshoot and repair the Degaussing System.
5. The impact to your mission (i.e., the specific harm that would result) if you do not receive the material or service by the required delivery date. (Note: Delays in production schedules alone or failure to expend monies are not acceptable reasons for justifying urgency.)
This fault increases the magnetic signature of the ship and makes it more susceptible to attracting enemy weapons.
6. Estimated production lead time for the item (how long will it take the contractor to produce the item gets a contract) as soon as possible 12 to 18 weeks
7. If the requirement is urgent and includes options, why are the options also urgent? _____
