**JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL  
FOR USE OF OTHER THAN FULL AND OPEN COMPETITION  
(SOLE SOURCE)**

**1. CONTRACTING ACTIVITY:** The contracting office is the NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Norfolk (FLCN), 1968 Gilbert Street - Suite 600, Norfolk, VA 23511-3392 and the requiring activity customer is the Navy Expeditionary Logistics Support Group (NAVELSG) 593 Mayfield St., Williamsburg, VA 23185-5831.

**2. NATURE/DESCRIPTION OF THE ACTION/CONTRACT TYPE**

This Justification and Approval is a sole source action for an extension of services under a firm fixed-price contract N00189-07-P-0704 to provide continued annual maintenance, support and upgrades of crane simulator systems in support of NAVELSG. This modification to contract N00189-07-P-0704 is necessary for continued services for an additional six months. The existing contract will expire on 30 April 2012 and this extension must be in place by 27 April 2012.

**3. DESCRIPTION OF REQUIRED SERVICES**

The initiation of a modification is essential to extend the performance end date of the current contract in support of NAVELSG. NAVELSG is a component command of the Navy Expeditionary Combat Command (NECC). The current effort includes maintenance, support and upgrades for 12 ML-1000 and 10 ML-2000 crane simulator systems at various CONUS locations. The proposed modification will be issued to GlobalSim, Inc. who is the current provider of these services. The initial requirement was synopsized in accordance with FAR 5.201 as a 100 percent small business set-aside on 20 March 2007. The six-month extension period, which will commence on 1 May 2012 and end on 30 October 2012 has an estimated dollar value of [REDACTED]

**4. IDENTIFICATION OF STATUTORY AUTHORITY**

The contract extension will be pursuant to 10 U.S.C. 2304(c)(1) only one responsible source and no other supplies or service will satisfy the agency requirements as implemented by Section 6.302-1 of the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR).

**5. RATIONALE JUSTIFYING USE OF AUTHORITY CITED ABOVE:**

The service provider for the current contract is GlobalSim. The GlobalSim contract has been in place for a base year and all four available options have been exercised. GlobalSim has been performing successfully under the contract. This six month extension to the current contract is necessary to continue service until a follow-on contract is competed and awarded in October 2012. GlobalSim is best positioned to continue providing these services under the current contract during the period required to compete and award a follow-on contract. Failure to extend the period of performance of this contract would lead to a break in services, presenting operational risk because of unacceptable delays in fulfilling the requirement through other methods and leave NAVELSG with no maintenance and support service for their crane simulators.

**6. FEDBIZOPPS Announcement/Potential Sources.** Notice of the contract extension will be posted to NECO pursuant to FAR 6.305.

**7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.** The Contracting Officer has determined that the anticipated cost to the Government for the maintenance and support services covered by this J&A as fair and reasonable based on the current contract prices for the current fourth option period of the contract, which was determined fair & reasonable at time of contract award based on price analysis using the CPI and the GlobalSim Master Price List.

**8. Other Supporting Facts.** None.

**9. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.** This contract extension is intended to ensure the continuation of services until the follow-on contract is competed to the fullest extent possible and awarded. The estimated award date is 20 October 2012.

**10. Estimated Dollar Value of the Acquisition Covered by this J&A.** The estimated dollar value associated with this extension is [REDACTED]

**11. Reference to the Approved Acquisition Strategy (MOPAS).** The Acquisition Strategy was approved on 26 March 2007.


