

The Naval Support Activity (NSA)/Naval Support Activity Weapons System Support (NAVSUP WSS) Philadelphia, PA presently employs an electronic Security Management System for alarm monitoring, card access control and intrusion detection. This system constantly evolves by updating equipment, material and devices to meet current and future security requirements. To implement updates and modifications, NAVSUP WSS needs 1) material, equipment, and devices that are compatible with the system's Lenel Onguard database and operating system software and 2) qualified and experience resources that have the knowledge and capability to provide and install surveillance, alarm system, access control and intrusion detection equipment/devices/hardware and programming support.

M3T Corporation is a veteran-owned small business specializing in system integration (video surveillance, access control, badging, intercoms), hardware integration (door hardware, keying/locksmith, safes/vaults), automatic access integration (powered pedestrian doors & vehicle gates), technical services and cyber security (network services & security assessments), and service integration (maintaining security system). M3T holds Lenel master certifications that are unique qualifications required to provide the needed CSS.

M3T has been providing NAVSUP WSS operational and security management CSS installation for several years and have delivered timely and cost-effective support ensuring NAVSUP WSS continues to provide and maintain the security of the facility and personnel. NAVSUP WSS intention is to hold one Contractor responsible during the length of the Period of Performance under a maintenance contract N00189-14-P-Z816 for all work to the Security System.

The purpose of this requisition is to procure a Purchase Order with M3T Corporation to provide new work/support services with Lenel Systems that are necessary because of the proprietary nature of the Security Management System. Currently, M3T Corporation, under Purchase Order N00189-14-P-Z816, is providing Lenel maintenance for emergency and non-emergency services at the same activity's site and is familiar with Lenel's current operating systems and conditions at these facilities. Based on the technical knowledge and expertise of the requiring activity, it has been determined that it is essential for continued support to be provided by M3T Corporation as the cost to change the contractor during this time would not be cost effective to the Navy and national security in reengineering time and expense.

A market survey was performed for the equipment/material/devices that are needed for this effort by review of catalogs, internet, contract equipment list and GSA Advantage. Through a current Maintenance Contract with M3T labor rates have been set for the length of the Period of Performance for this instant requirement.
