JUSTIFICATION AND APPROVAL
FOR SOLE SOURCE PROCUREMENT
Under Commercial Item Test Program FAR 13.5

1. Contracting Activity.

Fleet and Industrial Supply Center, Puget Sound

2. Description of Action Being Approved.

Award of a contract on a sole source basis for class B overhaul and conversion on two each JP5 purifiers in support of the USS Nimitz from Alfa Laval Inc., Chesapeake, VA.

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

The procurement is for services to perform a Class "B" overhaul and conversion/upgrade of two each JP5 Purifiers as per General Notes 31 of ECP 0201 CVN 68, Dwg. 504-7064826 Rev A and TM S9542-AE-MMO-010. The estimated cost for the services is (b) (5) Services are required to be completed by February 25, 2011. Funding is FY11 O&MN.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Sole Source.

- Section 4202 of the Clinger-Cohen Act of 1996 - a sole source acquisition under the authority of the test program for certain commercial items, as implemented by FAR 13.501(a).

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority.

Alfa Laval is the original equipment manufacturer of these particular JP5 purifiers from the CVN 64, USS Ranger, and the existing purifiers installed aboard the CVN 68 and other carriers. Alfa Laval is to accomplish services to do a Class "B" overhaul and conversion/upgrade of 2 each JP5 Purifiers as per General Notes 31 of ECP 0201 CVN 68, Dwg. 504-7064826 Rev A and TM S9542-AE-MMO-010. The units will be provided as Government furnished equipment from the CVN 64 to be installed on the CVN 68 after the overhaul is completed. The contractor

is required to disassemble, clean and inspect (DCI) the units upon receipt, perform a standard repair to include consumable parts (i.e. rubber rings, screws, gaskets, bearings and o-rings for bowl), repair of all weldable centralizing diameters in the bowl assembly, general polishing and machining and bowl balance to OEM specifications, rebuild utilizing class "B" parts and test of machine as well as a standard motor repair. In addition, complete conversion of two each JP5 Purifiers from 200 to 300 gallons per minute.

Alfa Laval is the only company that can provide the technical services for the class B overhaul and modification upgrade on the OEM's JP5 purifiers. Upon completion of the overhaul, the JP5 purifiers must meet and ensure no deviation from form, fit function or design, in order to ensure it interfaces satisfactorily with other components and operates efficiently aboard the CVN 68, USS Nimitz. Alfa Laval is required to ensure the end result is compliant with required NAVSEA drawings, standards, and specifications. All references and deliverable items associated with this requirement are unclassified.

Due to OEM procurement of long lead time materials required to complete the class B overhaul, the contract needs to be awarded on an urgent basis to ensure the required delivery date of February 25, 2011, of the two units to PSNS is met. PSNS then has to complete the onboard ship installation by March 7, 2011, to meet CVN 68's schedule.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable.

The proposed contract will not be synopsisized on the NECO website per FAR 5.202(a)(2), exception due to urgency. No additional market research was conducted because it is not practicable, for the reasons discussed in paragraph 5 above, for any company other than Alfa Laval Inc. to provide the required services.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.

The contracting officer has determined the anticipated cost to the Government of the services covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 5, FISC Puget Sound has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, FISC Puget Sound will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
