LIMITED SOURCE JUSTIFICATION

1. Identification of Agency and Contracting Activity.

NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound, in support of (b)(3) [REDACTED] intends to procure the following services and supplies on a limited source basis under the authority of the Multiple Award Schedule Program.

2. Nature/Description of Action.

This is an only one responsible source requirement action to be issued as a modification to contract N00406-13-F-0069, awarded as a firm-fixed price, services type contract to Dresser-Rand Company, Chula Vista, CA. The modification will include increased scope of work and additional parts for the repairs to the Ship's Service Air Compressors (SSAC).

3. Description of Supplies/Services, Estimated Value and Funding.

The contract was awarded on 25 January 2013 to Dresser-Rand Company on a sole source basis in the total amount of \$413,929.35. The contractor is to perform on-site Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) repair services, deliver and install all replacement parts, and operational testing in accordance with the OEM drawings and OEM repair standards to SSACs #1, #2, and #3 in support of (b)(3) [REDACTED] (b)(3)

The modification supported by this J&A is requesting an increase to the scope of the contract to provide sealing surface repairs to the sub base cover plates and cartridge, casing repair, and additional repair parts to be replaced on SSAC #1, #2, and #3 to include labor, freight, and other direct cost. The place of performance is (b)(3) [REDACTED] at U.S. Naval Base Yokosuka, Japan. The period of performance remains unchanged from 1 February 2013 through 30 April 2013. The estimated cost for the additional scope is (b)(5) [REDACTED] for this modification. The total estimated amount of the contract

including this modification is (b) (5) Fiscal Year 2013 (FY13) O&MN funding is provided for this modification.

4. Identification of the Justification Rationale, and if applicable, Demonstration of Contractor's Unique Qualifications.

8.405-6(a)(1)(i)(B) Only one source is capable of providing the supplies or services required at the level of quality required because the supplies or services are unique or highly specialized.

Dresser-Rand Company is the sole designer, developer and manufacturer of the SSAC units (b)(3) (CVN 73). The existing installed SSAC units are complex and engineered for aircraft carrier applications. NAVSEA requires all repair and replacement parts be OEM per T/M S6220-AR-MMI-A10. All components/parts of the SSAC's and HPAC's are proprietary to the OEM. Therefore, Dresser-Rand Company is the only contractor with the requisite knowledge, experience and technical data that can provide the required replacement parts and technical representative services for these air compressors. Puget Sound Naval Shipyard (PSNS) is the technical authority for this repair and requires the OEM to provide assessments, repairs and restorations of the SSAC compressor units in accordance with the OEM repair standards prior to ship deployment.

Delaying the purchase under the proposed contract until the development by other potential sources of conforming replacement parts would drastically delay deployment schedules, creating significant financial and mission costs for the U.S. Navy that outweigh any anticipated benefit from competition under the proposed contract. Additionally, reverse engineering costs per part are estimated based on one engineer at a rate of (b) (5) per day, requiring a minimum of (b) (5) to develop a drawing. The time and cost for approving part drawings and specifications would vary based on the part being reverse engineered. The cost to the government to have other than the OEM manufacture the parts could increase costs per part by more than double.

The newly identified additional repairs to the Ship's compressors could not have been anticipated prior to Dresser-Rand's open and inspect work was performed on the compressors, which did not occur until after performance for contract N00406-13-F-0069 had begun. The additional scope includes resurfacing the corroded sealing surfaces to SSAC#1 sub base cover plates, repairing damaged O-ring lands to SSAC#2 cartridge casing, casing repair to SSAC#3, and installing additional replacement parts that were determined to be beyond economical repair by the OEM.

5. Determination of Best Value.

The Fleet Logistics Center Contracting Officer will determine that the order represents the base value consistent with FAR 8.404(d).

6. Description of Market Research.

The proposed contract action will be synopsisized on the NECO website per FAR 5.201. No additional market research was conducted because it is not practicable, for the reasons discussed in paragraph 4 above, for any company other than Dresser-Rand Company to provide the required services, repair parts, installation and operational testing.

7. Any Other Supporting Facts.

This procurement uses GSA Schedule SINS 812-002 Dockside Maintenance and Repair Services, 003-100 Ancillary Supplies and Services, to be solicited and awarded in accordance with FAR Subpart 8.4.

8. Actions Taken to Remove or Overcome Barriers that Limit Sources.

For the reasons set forth in Paragraph 4, Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound has no plans at this time to compete future contracts for the types of supplies/services covered by this document. If another potential source emerges, Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound will assess whether competition for future requirements is feasible.
