LIMITED SOURCE JUSTIFICATION FOR FSS ORDER (above SAT)

1. **IDENTIFICATION OF AGENCY AND CONTRACTING ACTIVITY:** This is a Limited Source Justification. The requiring activity is Puget Sound Naval Shipyard and Intermediate Maintenance Facility (PSNS&IMF), Bremerton, WA, and Puget Sound Detachment San Diego at Naval Air Station North Island, San Diego, CA. The contracting activity is NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound.

2. **NATURE/DESCRIPTION OF CONTRACT ACTION:** This acquisition is conducted under the authority of the Multiple Award Schedule Program (Title III of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949 (41 U.S.C. 251, et seq.) and Title 40 U.S.C. 501, Services for Executive Agencies). This is a limited source action to be awarded as a new Federal Supply Schedule order to Safety Kleen Systems, Inc. identified in paragraph 3 below. The placement of a firm-fixed price order is anticipated.

3. **DESCRIPTION OF REQUIRED SUPPLIES/SERVICES:** The contractor shall provide all labor, material, and equipment to install, maintain and refill approximately 40 leased parts washers or maintain and refill several parts washers owned by the Government, including disposal of hazardous waste for two parts washers at San Diego, CA, and recycle haz-waste from all parts washers at various locations at the Bremerton Naval Complex in Bremerton, WA.

PSNS&IMF currently uses six different types and sizes of parts washers for a total of approximately 40 individual parts washers. The size and type is dictated by the individual needs of each user shop utilizing them. In addition to the parts washers is the requirement to exchange used solvent with clean and to recycle the waste solvent. The proposed acquisition is to enable PSNS personnel to be able to Clean Parts and Reassemble equipment in a timely manner. It is intended to acquire these services by leasing various size parts cleaner tanks as requested by various shops. Period of performance is 01 April 2013 - 31 March 2018. The total estimated dollar value of this order is (b) (5) base year, plus four one year options estimated at (b) (5) per year, total (b) (5)

4. **IDENTIFICATION OF THE JUSTIFICATION RATIONALE AND/OR DEMONSTRATION OF CONTRACTOR'S UNIQUE QUALIFICATIONS:** The statutory authority which permits restricting consideration of schedule contractors to fewer than that required in FAR 8.405-2 is 41 U.S.C. 251, as implemented by FAR 8.405-6.

The proposed requirement is to acquire Parts Washers, Service, Hazardous Waste Disposal and Waste Solvent Recycle Services to various buildings within the Bremerton Naval Complex, Bremerton, WA and Puget Sound Naval Shipyard Detachment San Diego, CA. Safety-Kleen Tanks meet the environmental emissions controls for PSNS & San Diego. The vendor is licensed to recycle their solvent which reduces our PSNS&IMF and San Diego waste streams.

Previous GSA contract order N00406-09-F-0205 was competitively solicited via GSA ebuy but only Safety-Kleen submitted a quote. For award of the previous contract, Request for Quote # N00406-09-T-0638 was posted to GSA Ebuy website and sent via email to all 36 FSS contractors for FSS schedule 56, SIN 253-40 and 253-49 on 3 March 2009. GSA Ebuy provided a fair notice of the intent to make the purchase to all contractors (30 small business and 6 large business concerns) offering the required services under the applicable multiple award schedule. This fair notice of the intent included a description of the services the contractor shall perform and the basis upon which award would be made. The contract specialist did not receive quotes from at least three FSS contractors. Of the 36 FSS contractors that were notified by email via ebuy, one quote, from Safety-Kleen, a large business, was received, in the amount of (b)(5) For the base year and three one-year options, that can provide both the recycling services and leased parts washers. There was also one quote received from a small business vendor that could provide leased parts washers but not the recycling services. Thirteen small business vendors submitted no quotes stating at GSA ebuy that they do not offer both of these services.

Therefore, based on previous acquisition history, for this new requirement, a limited source justification is being approved for Safety-Kleen Systems, Inc., a large business, stating availability of these services/supplies through optional use GSA contract number GS-07F-0122L, under Federal Supply Schedule 56, Special Item No. 253-40 Environmental Equipment and Services. Pursuant with FAR 8.405-6(a)(1)(i)(C), in the interest of economy and efficiency, the new work is a logical follow-on to an original Federal Supply Schedule order provided that the original order was placed in accordance with the applicable Federal Supply Schedule ordering procedures. The new solicitation will be posted to GSA ebuy website and all 17 current GSA contract FSS 56, SIN 253 40 holders will be solicited, and all proposals received will be considered.

This follow-on order is a new procurement to be placed with a particular contractor to continue a specific service. This specific requirement continues to be a recurring need to accomplish cleaning of parts by PSNS employees. It is beneficial to the Government for this particular contractor to continue to provide leased parts washers and solvent recycling services since they possess the variety of parts cleaner tanks required by PSNS per FAR 16.505(b)(4)). This contractor's equipment is already installed at 40 sites located in the Bremerton Naval complex, and it would not be practical to have another contractor replace the 40 leased parts washers and still meet schedule

thus causing unacceptable delays in fulfilling the Government's requirements.

5. **DETERMINATION OF THE BEST VALUE:** GSA has already determined the prices of the fixed-price services of the schedule contracts to be fair and reasonable. Therefore, ordering activities are not required to make a separate determination of fair and reasonable pricing. The NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound Contracting Officer will determine, using the procedures in FAR 8.405, that the order represents the best value and results in the lowest overall cost alternative (considering price, administrative costs, etc.) to meet the Government's needs. The contracting officer may, also, seek additional discounts before placing the order.

6. **DESCRIPTION OF MARKET RESEARCH:** The requiring activity and contracting activity have conducted market research among schedule holders. The requiring activity certifies that the requirement can be met by a commercial item and provides supporting documentation which is attached.

7. **ANY OTHER SUPPORTING FACTS:** This procurement uses GSA Federal Supply Schedule 56, special item number 253 40, and will be solicited and awarded in accordance with FAR Subpart 8.4.

8. **ACTIONS TAKEN TO REMOVE BARRIERS TO COMPETITION:** All future requirements will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
