1. Contracting Activity.

NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Puget Sound (FLCPS)

2. Description of Action Being Approved.

USNH Okinawa Japan requires the lease for six additional months and 3 option months for four medical towers and consumables. The additional months will raise the total contract cost to

3. Description of Supplies/Services.

The Stryker towers have multiple components and accessories, for use by various surgical services (General Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery, Urology, Gynecology, and Otolaryngology). The video towers serve to provide continuous arthroscopic, laparoscopic, and endoscopic surgical capabilities at USNH Okinawa.

4. Statutory Authority Permitting Sole Source.

Section 4202 of the Clinger-Cohen Act of 1996 - a sole source acquisition under the authority of the test program for certain commercial items, as implemented by FAR 13.501(a).

5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority.

The medical equipment is currently leased under contract #N00406-14-P-5359 to American Medical Depot (AMD). A procurement request for a new contract has already been awarded to Karl Storz on N00406-15-P-0469. However, that contract was terminated due to a protest by AMD. The new medical equipment will now be re-procured by NAVMEDLOGCOM. The customer cannot operate the

emergency room without the medical equipment currently in USNH Okinawa, Japan.

The current bridge contract will expire on 28 Dec 14, it is necessary to maintain the hospital's current surgical capabilities with no lapse in services. The additional 6-9 months will provide continuity of services and capabilities without disruption to patient care and surgical services. The video towers require specific accessories and consumable items. Currently supplies and inventory are compatible with the equipment leased. As part of the bridge, it is vital to maintain current equipment, accessories, and consumables in order to maintain consistency with user knowledge, compatibility with inventory stores, and prevent any service disruption due to a change in equipment.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable.

Market research indicates that only the proposed service provider is capable of providing the required services. The changes within this modification will be publicized, via NECO, with a post award synopsis.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost.

The contracting officer has determined the anticipated cost to the Government of the supplies/services covered by this J&A will be fair and reasonable.

8. Actions to Remove Barriers to Future Competition.

The new requirement for the lease of 7 surgical towers will be competed as competition was found during market research.
