

This is a COMBINED SYNOPSIS/SOLICITATION for commercial items prepared in accordance with the information in FAR Subpart 12.6, using Simplified Acquisition Procedures under the test program for commercial items found at FAR 13.5, as supplemented with the additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; a written solicitation will not be issued. PAPER COPIES OF THIS SOLICITATION WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE. This combined synopsis/solicitation SHALL be posted on FEDBIZOPPS, and NECO (<https://www.neco.navy.mil/>).

The RFQ number is N00604-15-T-3084. This solicitation documents and incorporates provisions and clauses in effect through FAC 2005-83 and DFARS Publication Notice DPN 20150626. It is the responsibility of the contractor to be familiar with the applicable clauses and provisions. The NAICS code is 811310 and the Small Business Standard is \$7.5M. The proposed contract action is for commercial supplies or services for which the Government intends to solicit and negotiate with only one source under the authority of FAR 13.501(a)(1)(ii). Interested persons may identify their interest and capability to respond to the requirement or submit proposals. This notice of intent is not a request for competitive proposals. However, all bids, proposals, or quotations received by the closing response date will be considered by the Government. A determination by the Government not to compete this proposed contract based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the Government. Information received will normally be considered solely for the purpose of determining whether to conduct a competitive procurement.

#### **5237.102-90 Enterprise-wide Contractor Manpower Reporting Application (ECMRA)**

The contractor shall report contractor labor hours (including subcontractor labor hours) required for performance of services provided under this contract for NAVFAC HI via a secure data collection site. Contracted services excluded from reporting are based on Product Service Codes (PSCs). The excluded PSCs are:

- (1) W, Lease/Rental of Equipment;
- (2) X, Lease/Rental of Facilities;
- (3) Y, Construction of Structures and Facilities;
- (4) S, Utilities ONLY;
- (5) V, Freight and Shipping ONLY.

The contractor is required to completely fill in all required data fields using the following web address <https://doncmra.nmci.navy.mil>.

Reporting inputs will be for the labor executed during the period of performance during each Government fiscal year (FY), which runs October 1 through September 30. While inputs may be reported any time during the FY, all data shall be reported no later than October 31 of each calendar year. Quoters are reminded to include with their quotes the following, as well as any additional information and certifications with reference to the provisions contained herein:

- 1) Total Price, FOB point, a point of contact, name and phone number, business size, and payment terms. Each response must clearly indicate the capability of the quoter to meet all specifications and requirements.

- 2) A completed copy of 52.212-3 and its ALT I (Attachment III). If the quoter has completed the annual representations and certification electronically via the System for Award Management (SAM) Web Site, the quoter shall only complete paragraph (b) of this provision.
- 3) DFARS 252.209-7992 (Attachment IV) Unpaid Delinquent Tax Liability Provision.

Basis of Award: This requirement will be awarded to the quoter with the lowest price technically acceptable (LPTA) for Total Price. Technical acceptability will be contingent upon the quoter proposing to meet all requirements in the RFQ.
