QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

N00604-16-C-BOAT

**Question 1.** What is the name of the incumbent contractor and the associated contract number?

**Answer:** Metson Marine Services, Inc. / N68836-13-C-0042

**Question 2.** Are the requirements for Vessel Maintenance (N00604-16-C-BOAT) and Port Operations (N00604-16-C-PORT) currently fulfilled on one contract and are now being split into two?

**Answer:** Yes, currently both requirements are on one contract (N68836-13-C-0042) and are being split into two separate contracts. There will be additional contractor performance requirements in the newly separated contracts that are not covered by the current contract.

**Question 3.** What is the current contract award amount?

**Answer:** The current contract (N68836-13-C-0042), which combines Port Operations and Vessel Maintenance, was awarded for \$35,322,000 over a total of five years (base + four options).

**Question 4.** Will the contractor be paid for a set group of personnel that will be available for all necessary maintenance or will the contractor be reimbursed for all labor costs?

**Answer:** The contract will be fixed price meaning labor costs for a set group of personnel will be paid at a fixed monthly price.

**Question 5.** Do you think that the NAICS code for Vessel Maintenance support should be NAICS code 336611?

**Answer:** The Government has tentatively changed the NAICS code to 336611 (Ship Building and Repairing). A final NAICS decision will be documented in the solicitation.

**Question 6.** Will the number and description of vessels associated with this solicitation be given?

**Answer:** Yes, the number and types of vessels will be provided in a Technical Exhibit that accompanies the solicitation.

**Question 7.** Will the number and description of equipment associated with this solicitation be given?

**Answer:** Yes, the number and types of Government Furnished equipment will be provided in a Technical Exhibit that accompanies the solicitation.

**Question 8.** Will the number of employees and their job descriptions currently working to support vessel maintenance be provided?

**Answer:** Manning for the current contract will not be provided. Job descriptions of suggested labor categories for certain contractor tasks will be provided in the solicitation.
