Description:

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command Europe Africa Southwest Asia (NAVFAC EURAFSWA) intends to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a firm fixed-price contract for Installation of Photovoltaic System, located at Camp Ederle Vicenza Italy. The anticipated requirement will be issued under Solicitation N33191-11-R-0403. The anticipated solicitation is for all labor, supervision, transportation, materials, tools, and equipment necessary to provide Solar Panels and mounting racks, electrical cabling and duct banks, inverters, lightening protection, roofing, and connections to existing electrical distribution system. Solar panels will be installed on the roof of three buildings, Commissary, Arena and Ederle Inn. The roof construction for these buildings is both flat and sloped and includes both tiles and membrane roof systems. This installation will utilize both Cadmium Telluride and Silicone Polycrystalline solar panels. Installation will require the removal and replacement of roofing materials. Electrical requirements will include cabling, cable trays, conduit, concrete encased duct bank, inverters, transformers, upgrades to Low Voltage (LV) Switchboards, and breakers to connect to local power distribution system. All work under this project shall be performed by contractor that is SOA Certified OG9 Class V. The work will be for a Base period of 380 calendar days, which will contain a Firm Fixed Price (FFP) for CLIN 0001 inclusive of Commissary, Arena and Ederle Inn. All work inclusive of labor and material for the Installation of the Photovoltaic System.

This is not a Request for Proposal. This is a Pre-solicitation notice and prospective offerors will have access to the solicitation on EuroNECO at <https://euro.neco.navy.mil> and Federal Business Opportunities at <http://fbo.gov> website. The solicitation is expected to be posted approximately 24 March, 2011 and proposals are expected to be due on 27 April, 2011. Dates are subject to change. Procurement procedures per FAR 15 – Contracting by Negotiation will be used for this acquisition. Award will be based on the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable proposal. Evaluation factors will be identified in the solicitation. The anticipated solicitation will be advertized on the internet at <https://euro.neco.navy.mil>. All applicable documents will be posted on EuroNECO website. It is offeror's responsibility to check this site in order to be notified of any changes to this solicitation.

All contractors who plan to propose on Department of Defense Solicitations must be registered in the Central Contractor Registration (CCR) www.ccr.gov. In order to register in CCR, proposers must have a Dun and Bradstreet (DUNS) Number <http://fedgov.dnb.com/webform> and a Commercial and Governmental Entity (CAGE) Code (U.S. firms) or a NATO Commercial and Governmental Entity (NCAGE) code (foreign firms). http://www.dlis.dla.mil/Forms/Form_AC135.asp. The CCR requirement applies to all contract awards, regardless of the country where the work is performed.

Offerors are required to have SOA Certification OG9 Level V, in order to be eligible for award.
