

Pre-Solicitation Notice N33191-15-R-1428, Temporary Backup Power for Building 262, located at Naval Support Activity (NSA I), Bahrain in the Middle East

Purpose: This pre-solicitation notice N33191-15-R-1428 provides the U.S. Navy, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC), Public Works Department (PWD) located at Naval Support Activity (NSA I), Bahrain intent to award one firm-fixed price (FFP) commercial contract for leased temporary backup power.

There will be one (1) solicitation for one (1) award, within the geographical area of Bahrain.

Authority: U.S. Navy, Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC), Public Works Department (PWD) located at Naval Support Activity (NSA I), Bahrain is issuing this synopsis in accordance with FAR Part 5.204 Pre-Solicitation Notices.

Description: Provide temporary backup power solution (Redundant - hot standby configuration) to supply power to the three existing chillers ACC-1A, ACC-1b and ACC-2 located on the roof of Building 262 located at NSA I, Bahrain. Design, deliver, setup and provide services to maintain hot standby temporary backup power solution, and power distribution system, including Automatic Transfer Switch (ATS), Bypass Switch, Electrical Distribution Panels and all other materials and labor for the duration of the contract.

The chillers serve critical server rooms, UPS rooms, and other critical equipment in building 262. For this reason operations of the chillers must be ensured for the entire duration of the contract under any circumstances.

Contractor shall ensure that systems, equipment and services provided are able to meet the above mentioned critical statement for the duration of the contract.

The temporary backup power source shall be leased for the entire duration of the contract. The Government will not own the equipment at any time. At the end of the contract all equipment shall be removed from the site.

Fuel storage containers (including generator) must be provided with a secondary means of containment (e.g., dike) capable of holding the entire contents of the largest single tank plus sufficient freeboard to allow for precipitation and expansion of product. Alternatively, fuel storage containers that are equipped with adequate technical spill and leak prevention options (such as overfill alarms and flow shutoff or restrictor devices) may provide secondary

containment by use of a double wall container. Fuel tank shall meet UL 58 standard cover horizontal atmospheric-type UNDERGROUND steel tanks intended for the storage of flammable and combustible liquids. Underground tanks are not authorized. Permeability for containment areas shall be a maximum of 10⁻⁷ cm/sec.

Place of Performance: The performance of the work associated with this Pre-Solicitation Notice is the U.S. Navy, Naval Support Activity (NSA I), Building 262, Bahrain, which is located in the Middle East.

Competitive Acquisition: This will be a full and open competitive acquisition.

Contract Type: Firm Fixed Price

Period of Performance: This acquisition contains a base year with 4 one-year option periods for a total contract period of performance of 5 years (60 months).

Release Date of the Solicitation: It is anticipated for Solicitation No. N33191-15-R-1428 to be released on or about 30 June 2015, proposals will be due on or about 30 July 2015.
