16.c. Brief scope of work: The contractor shall provide all labor, management, supervision, tools, material and equipment required to perform infectious waste collection and disposal service. Hazardous waste can include but not necessary limited to: hazardous waste, hematological waste, infectious waste, isolation room waste, microbiology waste, pathologic waste and or similar waste in nature. Disposal of these waste materials shall follow all established Federal and State regulations and reporting protocols. This is a Firm Fixed Price and Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity – performance based contract.

Procurement Method: Best Value, price and other factors considered.

The NAICS Code for this procurement is 562219 and the annual size standard is \$12.5M. The contract term will be a base period of 12-months plus two option periods of 12-months each. Only the base period of the contract will offer a minimum guarantee. If the Government does not award a follow-on contract in time, the Government may require the Contractor to continue performance for an additional period up to six months under the Option to Extend Services clause.

This contract will replace a contract of similar services awarded in 2007 of which the values for the Firm-Fixed Price and Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity are approximately at \$900K. Information about the current contract and the incumbent contractor (e.g., value of last option exercised, firm name, address, etc.) will be included in the solicitation package. Requests under the Freedom of Information Act are not required for this information.

The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance and experience information, and a price proposal for evaluation by the Government.
