The Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Washington intends to issue a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Design Bid Build Construction, firm fixed-price contract for the Exhibit Display Lighting National Marine Corps Museum (NMMC) Phase II Addition Bldg. 1775 at the Marine Corps Base Quantico, VA.

The anticipated requirement will be issued under RFP N40080-16-R-0171. The RFP is expected to be posted to Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) at <https://www.neco.navy.mil> and Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) at [www.fbo.gov](http://www.fbo.gov) websites mid of August 2016.

This RFP will be solicited utilizing a one-phase competitive procurement, negotiation procedures under FAR Part 15. Evaluation will be conducted utilizing Best Value, Lowest Price Technically Acceptable. The Government intends to award one (1) firm fixed-price contract. This RFP is 100% set-aside for Small Businesses under the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code is 238210. In accordance with FAR 36.204, the construction magnitude of this project is between \$1,000,000 and \$5,000,000.

**Project Description:**

The work includes providing new exhibit display LED lighting in the galleries of the NMMC Phase II addition. Project includes all pipe and tension grid support system, electrical and controls necessary for the installation of new exhibit display lighting. Lighting fixtures and support material will coordinate with the LED display lighting and controls installed in the existing museum gallery area.
