Description:

1. This acquisition will be solicited as competitive to local sources in accordance with FAR 6.302-4. Local sources are those persons or entities normally resident and licensed to conduct business in Japan. Offers from non-local sources will not be considered under this solicitation, in accordance with the provisions of the U.S. - Japan Status of Forces Agreement.
2. The project is comprised of basic award and four (4) option periods and an option to extend service for additional 6 months in accordance with FAR 52.217-8.
3. The basic award (CLIN 0001 for FFP and CLIN 0002 for IDIQ, respectively) scope of work includes, but is not limited to provision of all labor, management, supervision, tools, materials, and equipment necessary to provide integrated solid waste management and recycling service at the combined arms training center, Camp Fuji and under controlled CATC Camp Fuji area:
4. Option CLINs 0003 through 0010 (FFP and IDIQ), are for the continuation of services as stated in item 4 above. Option CLIN 0011 and CLIN 0012 (FFP and IDIQ) are for extension of the performance of service for the period not to exceed six (6) months in accordance with FAR 52.217-8.
5. This procurement shall utilize the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable evaluation process in issuing one solicitation with the intent to award a Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Indefinite Delivery/ Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) services contract for the project entitled, "Solid Waste Management and Recycling Service at the Combined Arms Training Center, Camp Fuji and Under Controlled CATC Camp Fuji Area, Japan". If the Contracting Officer determines that the number of proposals that would otherwise be in the competitive range exceeds the number at which an efficient competition can be conducted, the Contracting Officer may limit the number of proposals in the competitive range to the greatest number that will permit an efficient competition among the most highly rated proposals based on technical factors that include: Corporate Experience, Past Performance, Management Plan and Technical Approach, and Safety.
6. Award will be made to the responsible offeror whose proposal, conforming to the solicitation, is the most advantageous and offers the best value to the Government considering price and technical evaluation factors. In making the best value award

decision, the LPTA process is selected as appropriate for this acquisition because the best value is expected to result from selection of the technically acceptable proposal with the lowest evaluated price. Proposals are evaluated for acceptability but not ranked using the non-price factors.

7. Unless otherwise indicated in the synopsis, this is an Internet-only solicitation. It is the bidders/offerors responsibility to check this site daily in order to be notified of any changes to this solicitation.
8. The solicitation will be issued on or about 17 June 2014. Proposals will be due on or about 18 July 2014 at NAVFAC FAR EAST Yokosuka, Japan at the time specified in the solicitation.
