The Government anticipates award of a Firm Fixed Price contract to the company whose quote with the lowest price that meets requirements.

This acquisition is to provide a comprehensive, five-day training course for Certified Energy Managers (CEM) at NAVFAC Far East, Yokosuka, Japan for thirty five (35) students. The contractor shall include all course materials, handbooks, four days of training, one-day proctoring of the exam which includes the cost of the CEM application and the exam.

- Energy Management Handbooks for each student, (35 students)
- Four days of training by two instructors,
- One day proctoring of the exam, and
