Specifically, if a 3-year term contract that is completed in June, 2016, is used, would that be acceptable (is completion required on date of submission of this proposal, or upon date of award of the contract)? Also, if a series of work orders are complete on one multi-year task order and interim ACASS ratings are provided, can we use the work orders completed under the ongoing task order as a project?</p>	<p>A completed project refers to a contract or task/delivery order in which a final product has been submitted and accepted by the base. Offerors may choose to include projects that have not been completed yet, however such projects may be rated lower when evaluating this criteria. A project that has not been completed as of the date of submission will be regarded as not complete.</p> <p>Work Orders will not be considered as projects.</p>
