The intent of this notice is to identify potential offerors for information and planning purposes and is not to be construed as a commitment by Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Far East, PWD Sasebo, implied or otherwise, to issue a solicitation or ultimately award a contract. An award will not be made on offers received in response to this notice in accordance with FAR 15.201(e). The Government is not responsible for the cost associated with any effort expended in responding to this notice.

NAVFAC Far East PWD Sasebo is currently seeking potential sources for a multiple year, Firm-Fixed Price (FFP) contracts for Delivery, Rental, Repair and Maintenance Services for Forklifts at CFAS Japan. This information will be used to determine immediate and future acquisition strategies.

The Contractor shall provide all labor, management, supervision, tools, material and equipment required to perform Base Support Vehicles and Equipment (BSVE) rental services for Forklifts at CFAS, Japan.

CONTRACTOR LICENSING REQUIREMENTS: Any contract resulting from this solicitation will be awarded and performed in its entirety in the country of Japan. Contractors must be duly authorized to operate and conduct business in Japan and must fully comply with all laws, decrees, labor standards, and regulations of Japan during the performance of the contract. Prior to award of any contract, offerors must be registered to do business in Japan.

STATUS OF FORCES AGREEMENT: The U.S. Government will not offer United States Official Contractor status under Article XIV of the U.S.-Japan Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) to any offeror awarded a contract under this solicitation; nor will the U.S. Government certify any employees of a contractor as Members of the Civilian Component under Article I (b) of the SOFA.
