TITLE: 2013 FIRE ANT TREATMENT @ LEJEUNE & JOHNSON FIELDS (8 Loc)

Scope of Work: The contractor shall provide all material, labor, equipment and supervision required to accomplish the following:

General description – The Contractor shall treat listed locations for one time **PEST** Control.

3. Pesticide/Herbicide Record Form dtd 24 Oct 2012
4. CD (GIS Map)

Detailed requirements and specifications:

1. Contractor must provide a copy of their current NC “GROUNDS or ORNAMENTAL & TURF” Pest Control License (Category/Phase Code: L) to FSC Inspector.
2. Contractor must comply within the base regulation ER-10-228-DM and use only D.O.D approved pesticides (see attachments 1 & 2).
3. **Contractor shall conduct field verification for EACH location prior to submitting their quotes.**
4. **The contractor shall apply Fire Ant Control that is on the approved list.**
5. **MANUFACTURER and/or CONTRACTOR shall GUARANTEE UP TO ONE (1) YEAR AFTER TREATMENT with no existence of active ant mounds. Upon notification, contractor shall revisit location (s) specified within the awarded contract and conduct a full inspection of the areas of the noted location (s). If fire ants still exist within the one year after the Beneficial Occupancy Date (BOD), contractor shall re-treat areas with no additional cost to the Government. After each retreat, a new pesticide form shall be submitted to FSC.**
6. Contractor shall notify tenant the day of pesticide application is being conducted and advise tenant to keep children and pets away from contaminated area for a specified timeframe.
7. Contractor shall provide the Field Management Record Forms (properly filled out for EACH location treated – see attachment 3) to the FSC Inspector at time of the final inspection. FSC will forward all the forms and copy of license to Public Works Operations, attention Kimberly Ingram.
