

**THIS IS A SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE ONLY.** This notice does **NOT** constitute a request for proposal, request for quote, or invitation for bid. The intent of this notice is to identify potential offerors for market research purposes and to determine whether to set-aside the requirement for small business concerns.

Naval Facilities Engineering Command Mid-Atlantic is specifically seeking 8(a) Small Businesses, HubZone Small Businesses, Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses, Women Owned Small Businesses, Economically Disadvantaged Women Owned Small Businesses or other Small Businesses with current relevant qualifications, experience, personnel, and capabilities to perform the proposed requirement.

The work includes, but is not limited to, furnishing all labor, supervision, management, tools, materials, equipment, transportation, incidental engineering, and other items necessary to provide monitoring, repairing, and preventative maintenance service to twenty-two (22) Veeder Root Environmental Monitoring Systems and three (3) Pneumercator Company Monitoring Panels, at Marine Corps Base, Camp Lejeune, NC. The contractor shall be responsible for providing a certified technician, an average of six hours per day 5 days per week, who will perform system checks and maintenance, including installing new systems, modifications, repairs, and performing other tasks. Veeder Root certifications are required to perform the work. A complete list of specifications will be included in the solicitation.

The Procurement Method is Commercial Items FAR Part 12.

The Government intends to award a Firm Fixed Price/Indefinite Quantity type contract with a base period of one year plus four (4) option years. The total term of the contract, including all options, will not exceed sixty (60) months. The Contractor may be required to continue performance for an additional period up to six (6) months under the Option to Extend Services Clause. In either case, the Government will not synopsize the options when exercised.

The North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code for this procurement is **811219**, Other Electronic and Precision Equipment (except Automotive and Electronic) Repair and Maintenance, the annual size standard is \$19,000,000.00. The contract will replace a contract for the services awarded in 2008 for an estimated total cost of \$417,264.00. The proposed contract is being considered for 100% set-aside for small business (SB). Interested SB concerns should, as early as possible but not later than ten (10) days of this notice, indicate interest in the acquisition by notifying the Contracting Officer's point of contact listed below. Award will be made to the responsible offeror whose proposal, conforming to the Request for Proposal (RFP); will be most advantageous to the Government in terms of price and technical capability.

All Small Business concerns are encouraged to respond. The Government will not pay for any information solicited. Respondents will not be notified of the results of this market analysis. One of the main functions of this synopsis is to assist the Contracting Officer in determining whether a Small Business concern set-aside is an acceptable strategy for this procurement.

The Government encourages all Small Businesses, or other Small Business concerns interested to respond, indicating interest in the acquisition by providing to the Contracting Office a capability statement and a positive statement of eligibility as a Small Business. The capability statement shall include the following:

- Ability to meet all technical requirements outlined in this notice

- Active in the System for Award Management Registration (SAM) with:
  - DUNS number
  - CAGE code
- Representations as Small Business or other Small Business Concern
- Small Business classification for NAICS Code 811219
- Be registered to use Wide Area Work Flow (WAWF) for Electronic Invoicing

If adequate interest is not received from Small Business Concerns, the solicitation will be issued as unrestricted without further notice.

The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which will require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance, and a price proposal for evaluation by the Government.

Notifications of interest must be submitted in writing via email; phone calls will **NOT** be accepted. Notifications that do not address all the required information will not be considered. Interested parties should respond as soon as possible but no later than close of business **12 October 2012**.
