Work will be performed at the Naval Support Activity (NSA) Crane, Indiana and the Glendora Test Facility, Sullivan, Indiana. The work includes the potential for multiple task orders for the maintenance, repair, and installation of utility system pipelines, primarily domestic water, fire protection water mains, gravity sewers, force mains, and incidental accessories and site restoration. Task order work may also include repair work related to domestic water and wastewater treatment facilities such as lift stations, pumps, water storage tank repairs (cathodic protection system, tank level monitoring, pumps, controls, and piping), controls, electrical and site work commensurate with project scope.

This contract does not include major repairs, renovations or new construction projects for the water treatment plant, the waste water treatment plant, and water storage tank facilities or work which is incidental to new building construction and major repairs or renovations to existing buildings.

The Government will award a single contract from this solicitation to the offeror whose proposal conforms to the solicitation and is the lowest price technically acceptable offer. The source selection procedures will be utilized in conducting this competitive negotiation, which will consist of the submission of price and technical proposals once the Request for Proposal is issued. The following factors will be used to evaluate the offers: past performance/experience, safety, and contractor work plan.

The term of the contract will be 12 month base period plus four 12-month option periods to be exercised at the Government's discretion. The total term of the contract shall not exceed 60 months. Estimated value for 60 months is not to exceed \$5,000,000.00.

The NAICS Code for this solicitation is 237110, Water and Sewer Line and Related Structures. The Small Business Size Standard is \$36,500,000.00.

This solicitation is a 100 percent small business set-aside. A sources sought notice was posted on December 9, 2014 under solicitation N40085-15-R-7905 to determine availability and capability of businesses to perform the requirement. Based on market research results, the procurement will be solicited as a 100% small business set-aside. NAVFAC Mid-Atlantic's Office of Small Business Programs concurs with the determination to solicit as a 100% small business set-aside.
