

SOURCES SOUGHT NOTICE FOR THE NEW CONSTRUCTION OF AN OVERHEAD CRANE AT NAVAL BASE KITSAP-BANGOR, WA.

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Northwest is seeking businesses capable of designing, building, installing, and testing a new overhead crane at Naval Base Kitsap-Bangor. A description of the work follows:

This project provides for new construction of two (2) traveling overhead cranes, each with a span of approximately 200 feet and minimum 120 ton capacity. This project's construction features involve new construction in a marine environment, located within a pile-supported wharf structure. The construction complexity consists of limited site access, limited site storage, and work inside and around occupied buildings on an active military installation.

In accordance with DFARS 236.204, the project price range is between \$10,000,000 and \$15,000,000.

All businesses are encouraged to respond. The appropriate NAICS Code is 333923.

THIS SOURCES SOUGHT ANNOUNCEMENT IS NOT A REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL. It is a market research tool being used to determine the availability and adequacy of potential sources prior to determining the acquisition strategy. The Government is not obligated to and will not pay for any information received from potential sources as a result of this announcement. It is requested that interested sources submit to the contracting office a brief capabilities statement package (no more than 10 pages in length, single-spaced, 12 point font minimum) demonstrating ability to perform the requested services identified in this survey. Pages in excess of 10 pages will not be considered.

NOTE: Requested information includes both corporate experience and past performance with the distinction being that corporate experience pertains to the types of work and volume of work completed by contractors that are comparable to the types of work covered by this requirement, in terms of size, scope, and complexity. Past performance relates to how well a contractor has performed.

Documentation should address, as a minimum, the following:

(1) Company profile to include number of employees, office location(s), DUNS number, CAGE Code.

(2) Corporate Experience: Project descriptions should demonstrate the ability to perform all of the following: design, fabrication, equipment electrification, assembly, crane installation, crane testing, and operational training. A relevant crane is considered to have a minimum of 60 ton capacity **and** a minimum span of 120 feet. Submit a list of projects completed, for up to **three (3)** overhead crane projects, completed within the last five (5) years.

(3) Past Performance: Submit relevant past performance information on the **three (3) projects submitted under Corporate Experience** for those that were completed or substantially

completed in the past five (5) years. Identify whether your firm acted as a prime or subcontractor, received any terminations or unacceptable performance ratings. Identify any relevant military past or current customers, Government agencies, or any other commercial work that is relevant.

(4) Quality Control: Describe the company's Quality Control (QC) Management System. Description should include the processes used to maintain quality control during fabrication including roles of personnel involved and procedures implemented. Include how the quality assurance organization monitors fabrication efforts and its communication chain with reporting requirements to higher levels of management. Describe how quality assurance of subcontractors and vendors is accomplished and documented. Describe the quality control and quality assurance processes and how they will be utilized. Request submittal of corporate QC procedures utilized during crane fabrication, list of recent audits and findings, any external certification and/or accreditations, and a QC organizational chart.
