

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD A CONTRACT WHICH INCLUDES SOLE SOURCE REQUIREMENT:

The Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Northwest is in the process of awarding a Firm Fixed-Price Contract to provide all labor, materials, and equipment to build a Explosive Handling Wharf #2 located at Naval Base Kitsap at Bangor, Silverdale, WA. The Explosive Handling Wharf #2 includes a requirement for the installation of Security Turnstiles at an estimated value range of \$10,000 - \$20,000. Strategic Weapons Facility, Pacific (SWFPAC) is required to provide a reliable system to prevent unauthorized personnel access through the personnel entry control point to be constructed under P-990. The turnstiles are an integral part of the system and are required to be compatible with the Sandia National Laboratory's (SNL) proprietary designed control systems. The control systems are required equipment in order to meet specific security requirements as outlined in the DODINST S5210.41M and specific United States Marine Corps CONOPs. The SNL control systems currently being used by SWFPAC are the Alvarado MSTX system. Alvarado MSTX turnstiles are the only "known" commercially available turnstiles to meet ALL SWFPAC security requirements and compatibility requirements of the SNL controlling system. However, in support of FAR Part 6.1 (Full and Open Competition), the Government is interested in seeking competition in meeting the SWFPAC turnstile requirement. Interested parties should provide equivalent tandem turnstile information for evaluation by the Government. This Notice of Intent is not a request for competitive proposals or proposals. No solicitation document exists and no contract award will be made on the basis of proposals or quotations received in response to this notice. Interested persons may identify their interest and capability to respond to the requirement, and must furnish detailed data concerning their capabilities to provide the product sought including pricing data and technical data sufficient to determine that a comparable source to the government is available. The Government will be the sole determiner regarding an Offeror's ability to meet the requirement. A determination by the government not to compete this requirement based upon responses to this notice is solely within the discretion of the government. Information received will be considered solely for the purpose of determining whether a comparable product is available and whether the requirement should be competed.
