Synopsis or Description

THIS PRE-SOLICITATION NOTICE IS BEING ADVERTISED AS A SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE, PERFORMANCE BASED SERVICES REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL.

THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO AWARD A FIRM-FIXED-PRICE CONTRACT UNDER REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL N44255-12-R-3003, OU B-2 MUNITIONS CLEARANCE NON-TIME CRITICAL REMOVAL ACTION, FORMER ADAK NAVAL AIR FACILITY, ADAK ISLAND, ALASKA. The NAICS Code for the proposed acquisition is 562910. The small business size standard is 500 employees. The Federal Supply Code is Z299 (Maintenance, Repair and Alteration/Other).

DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Naval Facilities Engineering Command, Northwest is seeking to award a Firm-Fixed-Price Contract to provide Remedial Services at the former Naval Air Facility, Adak Island, AK. The project includes all labor, material, equipment and associated costs to develop required project plans and complete munitions clearance of 10 areas of concern (AOC), totaling about 587 acres. Major work elements will include vegetation clearance, surface clearance, and subsurface clearance, in accordance with a yet-to-be-executed Action Memorandum. The project must be completed to the satisfaction of the Navy, State of Alaska, and the US Environmental Protection Agency. The period of performance will be 1,468 days from award.

AWARD INFORMATION: The Government will award one Firm-Fixed-Price contract resulting from this Request for Proposal to the responsible, responsive proposer whose proposal conforms to the solicitation considered to be the “best value” to the Government, price and technical factors considered. Proposers will be evaluated on Factor 1: Relevant Experience, Factor 2: Past Performance, Factor 3: Safety, Factor 4: Technical Approach, Factor 5: Schedule and Coordination, and Price. It is anticipated that all non-price evaluation factors when combined are approximately equal to price. The Government reserves the right to reject any or all proposals at any time prior to award; to negotiate with any or all proposers; use of tradeoff processes when it may be in the best interest of the Government to consider award to other than the lowest price proposers or other than the highest technically rated proposer; and to award to the proposer submitting the proposal determined by the Government to be the most advantageous (best value) to the Government. Proposers should be advised **THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO EVALUATE PROPOSALS AND AWARD WITHOUT DISCUSSIONS OR ANY CONTACT CONCERNING THE PROPOSALS RECEIVED.** Therefore, proposals should be submitted initially on the most favorable terms.
