

N61340-12-G-0001 F/A-18CD Aircrew Training Systems Class Justification and Approval (CJ&A) 11-5837

The Naval Air Warfare Center Training Systems Division (NAWCTSD) in Orlando, FL is responsible for the acquisition, modifications, and upgrades of the US Navy and US Marine Corps F/A-18 and EA-18G aircrew training systems. On March 29th 2012, NAWCTSD awarded a Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) to L-3 Communications Corporation, Link Simulation & Training Division (L-3 Link), Arlington, TX (N61340-12-G-0001) to meet the aircrew training needs for the F/A-18C/D Hornet aircraft program and to maximize F/A-18C/D Tactical Operational Flight Trainer (TOFT) commonality with F/A-18 E/F Super Hornet and EA-18G Growler TOFTs. To contract for these requirements with L-3 Link, a Class Justification and Approval (CJ&A) was approved for the procurement of training systems, modifications and upgrades of US Navy and Marine Corps F/A-18C/D aircrew training systems, which include three (3) additional TOFTs and thirty (30) deployable trainers based on the TOFT design, and the modification and upgrade of the F/A-18E/F and EA-18G TOFT hardware and software components that are common with the F/A-18C/D TOFT components (C&JA 11-5837).

Pursuant to FAR 6.305, this synopsis intends to meet the requirement for future contract awards that utilize BOA N61340-12-G-0001 by making publically available C&JA 11-5837. The Government will make this posting available for 30 days past the authority to utilize this C&JA, which expires on March 31st 2017. When meeting the requirements of FAR 5.301(a) for all future contract awards that utilize BOA N61340-12-G-0001, the context of the synopses will provide a link to this CJ&A posting thereby simultaneously meeting the requirements of FAR 6.305(a) and (d).
