

NAVAL FACILITIES ENGINEERING COMMAND ATLANTIC  
ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIAL ACTION CONTRACT

THIS PRE-SOLICITATION IS BEING ADVERTISED AS A 100% SMALL BUSINESS SET-ASIDE PROCUREMENT. The NAICS Code for this Solicitation is 562910: Environmental Remediation Services. The Size Standard is 500 employees. The Government intends to award a Cost Plus Award Fee, Indefinite Delivery Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) type contract for one base year and four one-year option periods. The total maximum value for the contract is \$100 million inclusive of the base year and all options. Work will be performed by the issuance of task orders.

The work includes remedial actions at environmentally contaminated sites predominately located at Navy and Marine Corps Installations and other Government agencies. The work under this contract will be performed predominately in NAVFAC Atlantic's area of responsibility; including the Continental United States (CONUS) and overseas including the Caribbean, Europe, the Middle East and Southeast Asia; but may be used world-wide. The principle geographical area this contract will encompass is Alabama, Alaska, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Kentucky, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Texas, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming, the areas of the Caribbean, Central America, and Puerto Rico. The Contractor may, however, be required to perform work at any Naval or Marine Corps activity in the area of responsibility covered by NAVFAC Atlantic. Work may also be added and performed anywhere outside of NAVFAC Atlantic's areas of responsibility, as required by the Government.

Potential tasks will include but are not limited to: performing remedial actions, removal actions, expedited and emergency response actions at sites, pilot and treatability studies, facility operation, maintenance, and instruction, other related activities associated with returning sites to safe and acceptable levels, developing work plans, range clean up and closure including range sustainability environmental program assessments, RCRA closures, site characterizations, hydrographic surveys, groundwater characterization studies, anti-terrorist/force protection (ATFP) hazmat release incident response and remediation of ATFP related hazmat such as anthrax or any chemical, biological or radiological agent. The contractor is responsible for identifying and obtaining permits, licenses, etc. required by current laws and regulations.

The Government will award a cost reimbursable contract resulting from this solicitation to the responsible proposer whose proposal conforming to the solicitation will be a BEST VALUE to the Government, cost and technical factors considered. Firms submitting technical and cost proposals will not be compensated for any expenses incurred in the preparation of their proposal. The solicitation will be issued on approximately 09 May 2011. The receipt date of proposals is approximately 10 June 2011. This solicitation will be available in electronic format only. All documents will be in the Adobe Acrobat PDF file format via the Internet. The free Acrobat Reader, required to view the PDF files, can

be downloaded from the Adobe website. The Request for Proposal will be made available via the Federal Business Opportunities website ([www.FBO.gov](http://www.FBO.gov)) and/or the Navy Electronic Commerce Online website ([www.neco.navy.mil](http://www.neco.navy.mil)). All prospective offerors should download all pertinent documents from the websites. Notification of any changes to this solicitation (amendments) will only be made on the FedBizOpps website. Therefore, it is the offerors responsibility to check the internet sites regularly for any posted changes to the solicitation. Requests for documents by telephone, fax, or email will not be honored.

All responsible small business offerors may submit a proposal for consideration. All interested offerors must be registered in the Department of Defense Central Contractor Registration (CCR) database. Be advised that failure to register in the CCR makes an offeror ineligible for award of DoD contracts.
