N62470-14-R-6003 Base Operations Support (BOS) Services located at U.S. Naval Medical Research Unit-3 (NAMRU-3), Cairo, Egypt.

The proposed contract will be a combination Firm Fixed Price Indefinite Delivery-Indefinite Quantity, performance-based contract for Base Operations Support (BOS) Services for NAMRU-3, Cairo, Egypt. The work includes, but is not limited to, providing all management, supervision, labor, materials, and equipment necessary to provide services for: General Information, Management and Administration, Facilities Support (Facilities Investment, Custodial Services, Integrated Solid Waste Management (ISWM), Grounds Maintenance and Landscaping, and Pavement Clearance), Electrical, and Base Support Vehicles and Equipment.

The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance and corporate experience information, along with a price proposal for evaluation by the Government. The best value lowest priced technically acceptable source selection process is anticipated to be used for this acquisition. The Government expects that the best value will result from selection of the technically acceptable proposal with the lowest evaluated price.

The NAICS Code for this procurement is 561210, Facilities Support Services and the annual size standard is \$35.5 million. The contract term will be a base period with four one-year option periods.

These services are currently being performed under contract N33191-10-D-0223 by Egyptian Co for Supplies and Services Ayad Sons. Information about the current contract and the incumbent contractor (e.g., value for the base year, firm address, etc.) will be included in the solicitation package. Requests under the Freedom of Information Act are not required for this information.

Offerors can view and/or download the solicitation, and any attachments, at <https://www.neco.navy.mil/> when it becomes available. It is the sole responsibility of the offeror to continually view the website for updates. The Government will not provide hard copies, facsimile or CD-ROM copies or Plan Holders Lists.

This procurement will be solicited on an unrestricted basis. A sources sought notice was posted to FedBizOps 05 February 2014 (N62470-14-R-6003) to determine availability and capability of businesses to perform the requirement. Given the nature of the work, there will be no state-side work and all services under this contract will be performed overseas; the Small Business Act does not apply and a subcontracting plan is not applicable. NAVFAC Atlantic's Office of Small Business Programs concurs with the determination to solicit as an unrestricted procurement.

All responsible sources may submit a proposal which shall be considered by the agency. All prospective contractors are required to be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) database at <https://www.sam.gov/portal/public/SAM/>.

The anticipated date of RFP issuance is on or about 31 July 2014. Proposal due date will be on or about 14 September 2014.
