N62470-14-R-6014, Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) – Solar Photovoltaic Systems at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling (JBAB), Washington, D.C.

The proposed contract will be a single award Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) and will be executed under the authority of 10 U.S.C. 2922a for up to a twenty-five (25) year contract term. The purpose of the PPA is to provide power by Photovoltaic (PV) generation systems that are developed, constructed, operated, maintained, owned, and financed by a private entity at Joint Base Anacostia-Bolling (JBAB), Washington, D.C.

The solicitation utilizes source selection procedures which require offerors to submit a technical proposal, past performance and renewable project experience information, along with a price proposal for evaluation by the Government. The best value lowest priced technically acceptable source selection process is anticipated to be used for this acquisition. The Government expects that the best value will result from selection of the technically acceptable proposal with the lowest evaluated price.

The NAICS Code for this procurement is 221114 Solar Electric Power Generation and size standard in number of employees is 250.

This is a new requirement. Offerors can view and/or download the solicitation, and any attachments, at <https://www.neco.navy.mil/> when it becomes available. Notices, amendments and responses to RFIs will also be posted to <https://www.neco.navy.mil/>. All prospective offerors are encouraged to register at <https://www.neco.navy.mil/>. This is the method that will be utilized for distributing amendments and other information to offerors. It is the sole responsibility of the offeror to continually view the website for updates. The Government will not provide hard copies, facsimile or CD-ROM copies or Plan Holders Lists.

This procurement will be solicited on an unrestricted basis. A sources sought notice was posted on NECO 06 May 2014 (N62470-14-R-6014) to determine availability and capability of businesses to perform the requirement. NAVFAC Atlantic's Office of Small Business Programs concurs with the determination to solicit as an unrestricted procurement.

All responsible sources may submit a proposal which shall be considered by the agency. All prospective contractors are required to be registered in the System for Award Management (SAM) database at <https://www.sam.gov/portal/public/SAM/>.

The anticipated date of RFP issuance is on or about 06 April 2015. Proposal due date will be on or about 21 May 2015.
