

## **N62470-15-R-4000 - ENERGY INDUSTRY DAY FOR NAVAL STATION GUANTANAMO BAY BEING HELD AT NAS JACKSONVILLE, FL**

Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Atlantic will conduct an Energy Industry Day for Naval Station (NAVSTA) Guantanamo Bay, Cuba on Wednesday, November 5, 2014 onboard Naval Air Station (NAS) Jacksonville. This Energy Industry Day provides an opportunity for Department of the Navy (DON) to present an overview of the holistic utility and energy goals at NAVSTA Guantanamo Bay (to include, but not limited to, energy resiliency, energy generation and distribution system reliability, energy security, energy conservation, energy efficiency, renewable energy generation) to Industry including the Energy Service Companies (ESCOs) currently holding U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Indefinite-Delivery, Indefinite-Quantity (IDIQ) Energy Savings Performance Contract (ESPC) contracts. In addition to obtaining market research information, another important aspect of this event is to foster communication and promote opportunities for subcontracting between other interested industry parties and the ESCOs.

It is NAVFAC's intention to pursue an Energy Savings Performance Contract (ESPC) through the DOE IDIQ to meet the utility and energy goals at NAVSTA Guantanamo Bay. ESCOs are awarded DOE IDIQ ESPCs based on demonstrated capabilities to manage the development and implementation of multiple ESPC projects worldwide. The sixteen ESCOs on the DOE IDIQ are the only firms that will be eligible for this award; as such, proposals from other firms will not be accepted.

All members of Industry interested in attending this forum are welcome and will have the opportunity to interface directly with ESCOs holding DOE IDIQ ESPC contracts. This forum will help identify potential opportunities for ESCOs to address meeting critical energy requirements and goals at NAVSTA Guantanamo Bay. The purpose of this Energy Industry Day event is to engage the ESCOs and industry in an interactive manner to support on-going market research efforts to develop a holistic solution and resultant acquisition strategy to potentially award an ESPC for NAVSTA Guantanamo Bay energy requirements.
