

## **N62470-15-R-4020- ENERGY INDUSTRY DAY FOR RENEWABLE AND CONVENTIONAL ENERGY TO U.S. GOVERNMENT FACILITIES IN ITALY**

Naval Facilities Engineering Command (NAVFAC) Atlantic will conduct an Energy Industry Day on Tuesday, April 12, 2016 in Rome, Italy.

This Energy Industry Day provides an opportunity for exchange of information between Department of the Navy (DON) and industry. The DON intends to issue a Draft Request for Proposal (DRFP) for Renewable and Conventional Energy at U.S. Government Facilities in Italy prior to the Industry day event on or about March 31, 2016. The DRFP will be published on Navy Electronic Commerce Online (NECO) and Federal Business Opportunities (FBO) ([www.neco.navy.mil](http://www.neco.navy.mil) and [www.fbo.gov](http://www.fbo.gov)). The purpose of this Energy Industry Day event is to engage industry in an interactive way to gather additional information to support on-going market research efforts associated with the potential project.
