5. Rationale Justifying Use of Cited Statutory Authority.

a. The FY13 budgetary impact caused by the year-long Continuing Resolution and across-the-board Federal spending cuts (sequestration) has resulted in a significant reduction in contracting resources, including NAVFAC Hawaii's basic MACC contracts. Since the current 8(a) MACC was awarded task orders have been extensively utilized in completing mission-critical projects during FY12 and FY13. The current 8(a) MACC is near its maximum dollar capacity of \$200,000,000 for task order awards. NAVFAC Hawaii's 8(a) MACC is recognized to be one of the most timely and cost-effective contracting vehicles for successfully completing life/safety and mission-critical projects on behalf of the Navy and its customers. It is a proven resource for meeting (and exceeding) the Navy's statutorily mandated goal of awarding 5 percent of all prime contracts and subcontracts to small disadvantaged businesses. Each 8(a) MACC contractor is a valuable and limited resource and no other contracting methodology is available at this time to satisfy the Navy's requirements identified in paragraphs 3.b. (1) through (9) above.

b. The previous market survey for this 8(a) MACC indicated that all 8(a) MACC contractors' prices were priced competitively and each demonstrated a proven track record for successfully completing projects with satisfied customers. Evaluations of completed task orders range from "Satisfactory" to "Outstanding".

c. Increasing the contract value of the current 8(a) MACC by \$12.5M is the most advantageous way to fulfill the Government's imminent and foreseeable contracting requirements while at the same time creating an environment for maximum participation for small, disadvantaged 8(a) contractors. No other resource can satisfy the Navy's needs as completely and cost-efficiently as the current 8(a) MACC. Although NAVFAC Hawaii is actively planning on other contracting vehicles to include utilizing Invitation For Bids (IFBs) and more small business sole source procurements, the need still exists for increasing the capacity of this 8(a) MACC to meet the immediate contract demands for FY15. No other small business MACC can satisfy this void except possibly the Service Disabled Veteran Owned Small Business (SDVOSB) MACC which is very close to its own maximum contracting capacity.

d. Competition. Projects designated for 8(a) MACC will be competed among the three remaining incumbents with the expectation that two or more offers will be received.

e. The three remaining Contractors are:

N62478-11-D-4041, Contech Engineering, Inc.
N62478-11-D-4042, GSI-ASI JV LLC
N62478-11-D-4043, Mega-Healy Tibbits A JV

All three incumbents have the appropriate financial and technical resources, experience and organizational controls needed to accomplish the work within the required or proposed delivery schedule.

f. The workload projection estimates were prepared and provided by Capital Improvements (CI) acquisition strategy, Echelon IV. Many of these projects have been and are projected to be funded at the design stage and once completed, will be funded for construction execution.

g. Based on previous task orders under this MACC, anticipation is that the three contractors will provide fair and reasonable competitive.

h. Based on the above, all three Contractors are the limited number of sources available that can satisfy agency needs and requirements since task orders are competitively awarded and prices are based on current market conditions.

6. Description of Efforts Made to Solicit Offers from as Many Offerors as Practicable. Projects designated for 8(a) MACC execution will be competed among the three remaining incumbents with the expectation that two or more offers will be received. A follow-on 8(a) MACC is being planned for FY15 to award approximately \$245 million work of contract task orders.

7. Determination of Fair and Reasonable Cost. The Contracting Officer has determined the anticipated cost to the Government of the work to be performed by this Justification and Approval will be fair and reasonable.


