5	<p>In the selection criteria, it states that 10 projects shall be included to address #1 – Specialized Experience. Does this mean that in our SF330 Part I, Section F, only 10 projects are to be included? Or does this requirement only relate to the inclusion of projects in the Section H narrative?</p>	<p>Relevant projects demonstrating specialized experience by the proposed team shall be identified in Part I of the SF 330 under Section F and are limited to 10 projects. Section H is for additional information specifically requested by the agency or to address selection criteria that are not covered by the information provided in Sections A-G. Additional projects shall not be included in Section H.</p>
6	<p>In selection criteria #2 - Professional Qualifications, it states that only 10 key personnel shall be included. Does this apply to Section E of the SF330 Part I, or only to the Section H narrative?</p>	<p>Professional qualifications and technical competence of the individual design team members shall be identified in Part I of the SF 330 under Section E and are limited to 10 key personnel. Section H is for additional information specifically requested by the agency or to address selection criteria that are not covered by the information provided in Sections A-G. Additional key personnel shall not be included in Section H.</p>
7	<p>In one paragraph it is stated that both volumes of the SF330 submittal shall be one-sided. In the following paragraph it states that “double-sided pages will be counted as two pages.” Are double-sided pages allowed for Volume II, if at all?</p>	<p>The printed format for both Volumes I and II shall be one-sided. However, if double-sided pages are submitted, the Government will count double-sided pages as two pages for the purpose of the page count limitation.</p>
8	<p>For selection criteria #9 – Volume of Work, does this apply to all consultants included on the team, or just the prime/JV entity?</p>	<p>Evaluation under Selection Criteria No. 9, Volume of Work, applies to Prime A&E Firms, which includes, but is not limited to, Joint Ventures, Limited Liability Companies, and Limited Partnerships.</p>
9	<p>If the submitting entity will be a joint venture, does the SF330 Part II for the JV entity need to be a consolidated document that includes information representing all of the members of the JV? Or should each member of the JV just submit a separate Part II?</p>	<p>Submit a separate Part II for each firm that will be part of the team proposed. If a firm has branch offices, submit a separate Part II for each branch office that has a key role on the team.</p>
10	<p>Since there is a page limit for Volume I, is it acceptable to include the required Joint Venture documents in Volume II?</p>	<p>Joint Venture documents may not be provided in Volume II but may be provided as an appendix to Volume I and, therefore, excluded from the page limitation. No other appendices to Volume I will be allowed.</p>
