TYPE OF SOURCES SOUGHT: This Sources Sought is designated for interested Small Business parties under NAICS CODE 336611 and PSC Code J020. Interested parties shall be NAVSEA certified contractors with experience in paint-removal, surface preparation, repainting, and air sampling of the interior of steel recompression chambers.

SCOPE:

The Requiring Activity (Naval Diving and Salvage Training Center, Panama City, FL) has a requirement for sandblasting, prep, prime, paint and Built-in Breathing System (BIBS) valve replacement of the Yard Diving Tender (YDT)– 17 & 18 Recompression Chamber.

II. REQUESTED INFORMATION

1. What experience does your company have with overhaul of recompression chambers as identified in the Scope? Provide proof of NAVSEA Certification.
2. Narrative explaining how your company could meet the potential requirement as identified in the Scope and information you may consider important regarding this Sources Sought.
3. Describe your company qualifications and corporate experience of the firm with regard to overhauling recompression chambers.
4. Identify if your company is a United State Business or Foreign Business; Advise, if your Company is controlled by a Foreign Government (DFAR 252.209-7002 DISCLOSURE OF OWNERSHIP OR CONTROL BY A FOREIGN GOVERNMENT (JUN 2010).
5. Provide Company Name, Point of Contact, email address, and SAM Cage Code information.
6. Past Performance – Does your company have relevant past performance within the last three years? Include contract numbers, contract type, dollar value of each contract, point of contacts, and brief description of work performed.

Responses to this Sources Sought should include supporting materials that will allow an effective evaluation of your company's competence, experience, and overall understanding of the requirement that NAVSUP Fleet Logistics Center Jacksonville has identified.
