Amendment Synopsis:

Requests for Information (RFIs)

RFI 6: In reviewing the recent Amendments posted we note that EMR's have been requested – for how many years?

RFI 6 RESPONSE: Submit only the current EMR.

RFI 7: Given the page count restriction and the response to Amendment 002 RFI 2, can we assume that the listing of information that we are required to provide related to performance ratings (tabular listing), projected workload/capacity, and recent project experience should be limited to the disciplines identified under the Evaluation Criteria heading "1. Professional Qualifications?"

RFI 7 RESPONSE: The intent is not to limit your ability to demonstrate your firm's performance ratings, projected workload capacity, or recent experience; but, the intent is to submit those informational items focused upon the items under Evaluation Criteria.

RFI 8: Regarding Part 3. Performance, Item E – “Designate your role in the project and identify the proposed team members that worked on these projects. These ratings should be dated

2006 or later and should include those for joint venture partners and consultants. Include points of contact (name & telephone number) for the client." Does this requirement correspond with Item B and C – ACASS Ratings or does it apply to Item D – Commendations/Awards OR does it apply to both B,C and D?

RFI 8 RESPONSE: For each project listed in your tabulation, you are required to provide the information in "3. Performance, e." as indicated; regardless of whether a project was performed for DoD or a different client.

RFI 9: Can I submit an organizational chart on an 11" x 17" sheet? Can all pages be 11" x 17"?

RFI 9 RESPONSE: No. The organization chart is the only page within the 60 page limit that may be 11" x 17".

RFI 10: Re: N69450-11-R-0052, criteria 1d) "An Architect and a Mechanical Engineer, each having active U. S. Green Building Council (USGBC) LEED accreditation and experience as the Architect/Engineer of record for a minimum of one (1) completed project that has received a minimum LEED Silver level certification from the USGBC". We have a mechanical engineer who is a Green Building Engineer and Certified Sustainable Design Professional – certifications which are parallel to the LEED AP program, with special emphasis on energy and air quality in building systems.

Are these certifications also acceptable to meet this criteria?

RFI 10 RESPONSE: No.

RFI 11: The current solicitations require "A licensed Engineer or Architect, certified as a Registered Roofing Consultant (RRC) by the Roof Consultant Institute (RCI) having a minimum of 10 years continuous experience in the design of roofing and waterproofing systems for new and existing structures of similar size and scope".

Considering the limited number of RRC's who meet this criteria in the project's geographic boundaries, could just the RRC, the previous criteria be used, or a firm with either a licensed Architect or Engineer, and an RRC?

RFI 11 RESPONSE: The requirement has been revised. Please see the conformed Scope in Amendment 0004.
